Incident timeline

25 Jan 2017	1	Fighting erupts in Bokenj.
03 Feb 2017	2	Fighting reaches Ogod.
	3	Fighting reaches Wau Shilluk. Population moves to Padit, Fathau, Biew in Fashoda.
04 Feb 2017	4 5	Shelling from Akoka area towards Lul, Padit and Fathau. IDPs from Wau Shilluk who had settled here move towards Kodok and Aburoc.
	6 7	
05 Feb 2017	8 9	Fighting erupts in Owachi in Panyikang county. People are displaced to Tonga, towards the forest in Wag Panyikang and in South Kordofan in Sudan.
	10 11	
11 Feb 2017	9 7	GFD to take place in Aburoc sometime in March and as a result IDPs in Tonga start moving towards Aburoc traversing unmarked routes mostly at night.

Methodology

Data collected 8 - 10 March 2017 through population headcount in Aburoc of IDPs from Wau Shilluk, estimations triangulated through focus group discussions and observation. Chief, RRC and beneficiaries were selected as key informants.
