Climate Change Vulnerability Index 2013 *



* The Climate Change Vulnerability Index evaluates the vulnerability of human populations to extreme climate related events and changes in major climate parameters over the next 30 years. The Climate Change Vulnerability Index combines the risk of exposure to extreme events, with the degree of current sensitivity to that exposure and the ability of the country to adjust to, or take advantage of stresses resulting from climate change. This is a global index: variance at the subnational level is relative to the global rather than the local scale.
