Food and nutrition security

The hunger crisis in Afghanistan is unfolding at a rapid speed.

The economic meltdown, on top of the existing conflict, drought and a COVID-19 pandemic threaten to plunge millions more into hunger.

USD 200M

required for the rest of 2021 (+ USD 30m for UNHAS), of which USD 142m has been received

USD 300M

required for just the first quarter of 2022
