## 18.2 million people

(52 PERCENT WOMEN) WERE ASSISTED IN THE 19 COUNTRIES ACROSS ALL ACTIVITIES<sup>1</sup> (+72% COMPARED TO 2019).



## 472,200 mt

of diverse commodities (mainly cereals and grains) distributed in 18 countries (+36% since 2019). This includes 278,400 mt (worth USD 133 million) procured locally and regionally.



## USD 266.6 million

of cash-based transfers (mainly through cash and vouchers) made in 15 countries (+70% since 2019), with USD 106 million of the transactions made in SCOPE<sup>2</sup>.



## 12.3 million

PEOPLE RECEIVED UNCONDITIONAL RESOURCE TRANSFERS

This includes **4.8 million internally displaced persons, refugees, and returnees**, as well as people affected by **COVID-19 and floods**.



## 1.4 million

CHILDREN AND PREGNANT AND LACTATING WOMEN RECEIVED MALNUTRITION TREATMENT

In parallel to malnutrition treatment activities implemented in 13 countries, **1.5 million** children and pregnant and lactating women in 15 countries also benefited from malnutrition prevention programmes.



## 91,800

PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV/TUBERCULOSIS ASSISTED

Nutrition support and food assistance were provided in 9 countries, while 14 countries implemented HIV/tuberculosis specific or sensitive activities.



## 3.4 million

SCHOOLCHILDREN REACHED

School meals and take-home rations (mostly for girls) were provided. Moreover during COVID-19 related school closures, WFP distributed **alternative take-home rations** in replacement of on-site school feeding, reaching **943,000 schoolchildren** in 13 countries.



## 180,700

SMALLHOLDERS SUPPORTED

Through the **Smallholder Agriculture Market Support programme** implemented in 14 countries, smallholders were able to sell 303,700 mt of their food produced through WFP-supported aggregation systems (worth around USD 14.1 million).



## 1.5 million

PEOPLE BENEFITED FROM LIVELIHOODS SUPPORT

This included participants of the **Food Assistance for Assets (FFA) programme** and their household members in 13 countries, who also received food assistance to cover their immediate food needs, while creating or rehabilitating assets.



## 1.7 million

PEOPLE BENEFITED FROM CLIMATE ACTION

Targeted people benefited from one or more **climate risk management solutions** implemented in 8 countries.



## 1.1 million

PEOPLE CLIMATE INSURED

Participants received USD 5.2 million as a result of insurance or forecast-based actions.

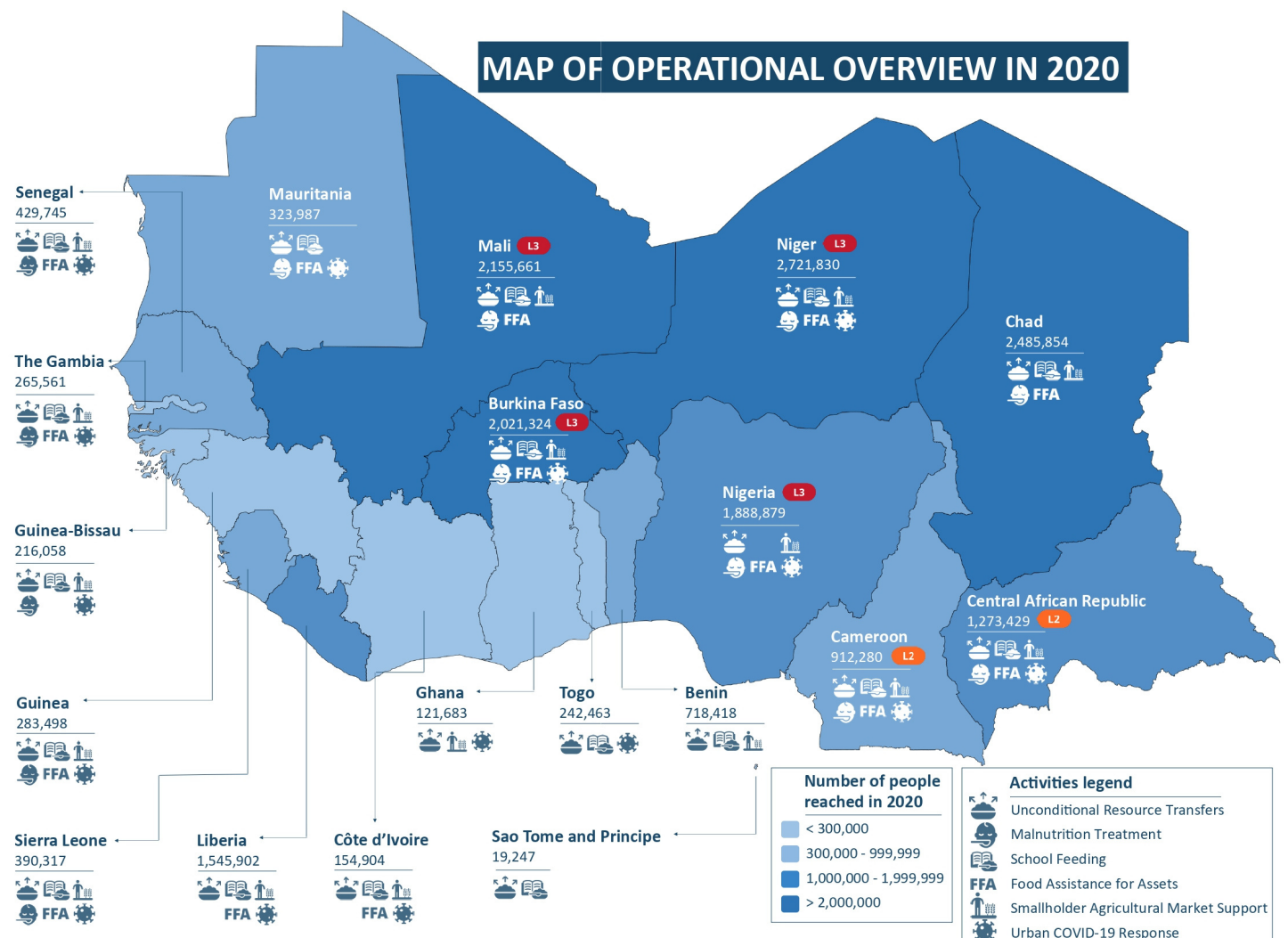
## USD 1.1 billion SPENT ACROSS ALL STRATEGIC RESULTS (+31% COMPARED TO 2019)

Funding requirements and funds raised in 2020 increased significantly as well (USD 1.85 billion and USD 1.74 billion respectively), due mainly to additional needs linked to COVID-19 socioeconomic impacts.
