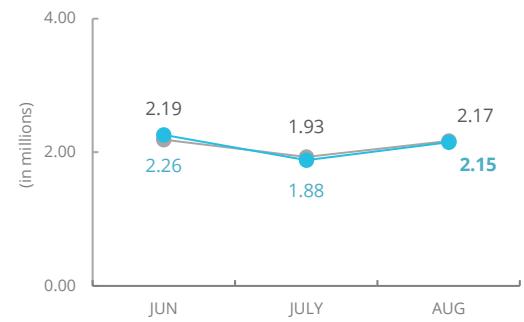


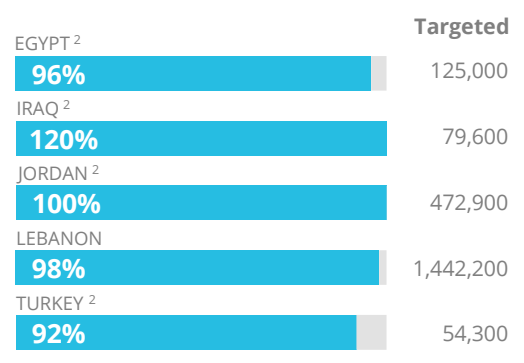

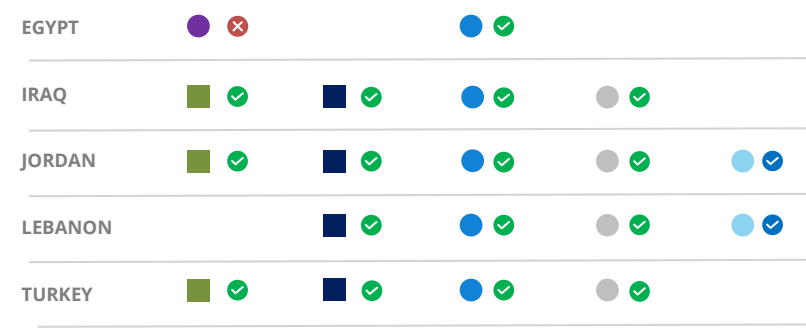

OPERATIONAL PROFILE By Activity (August)



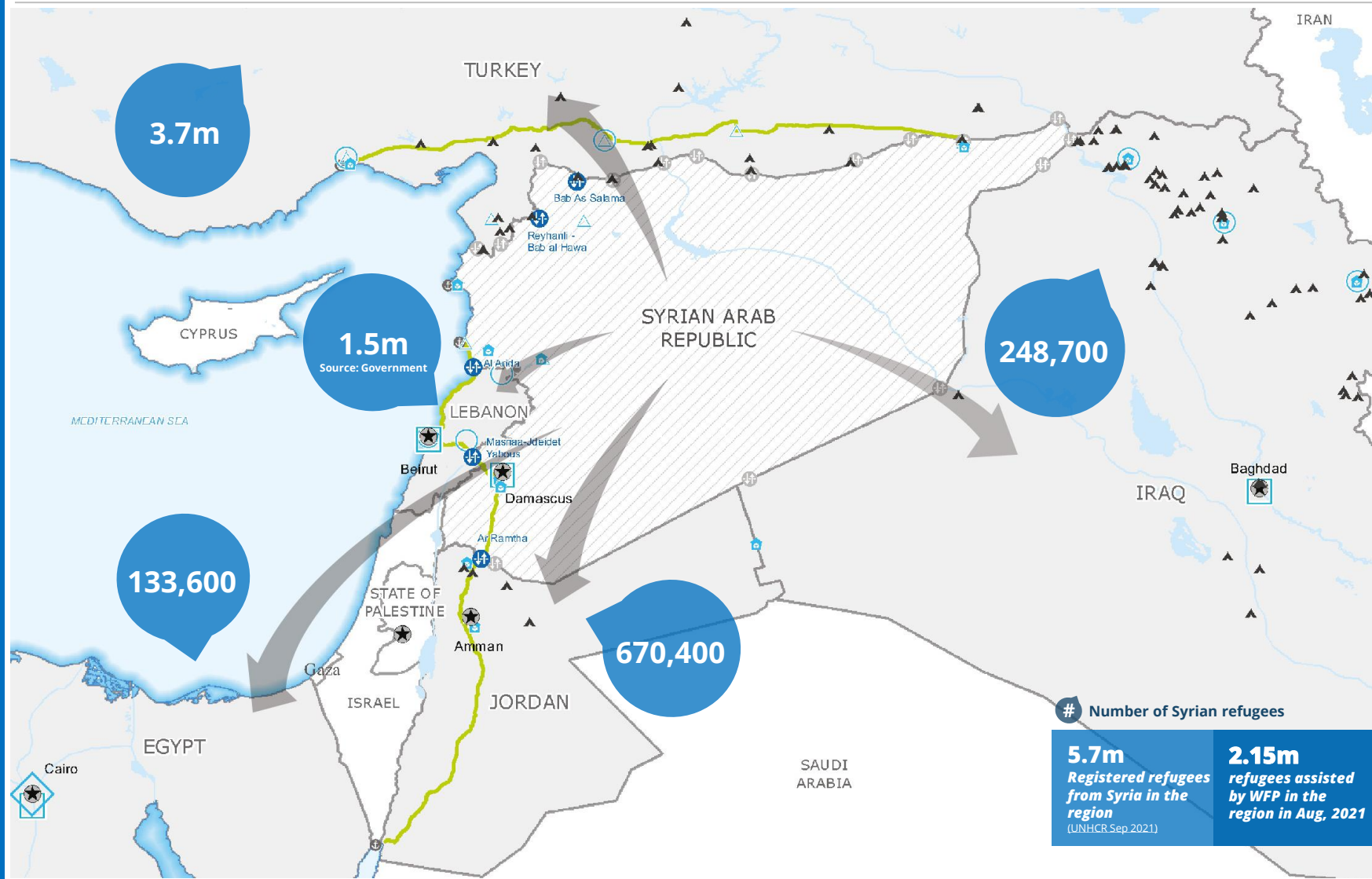

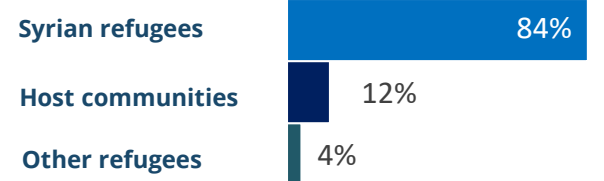
