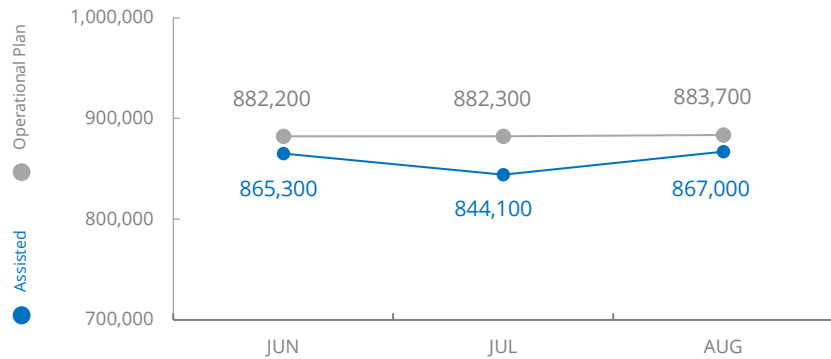

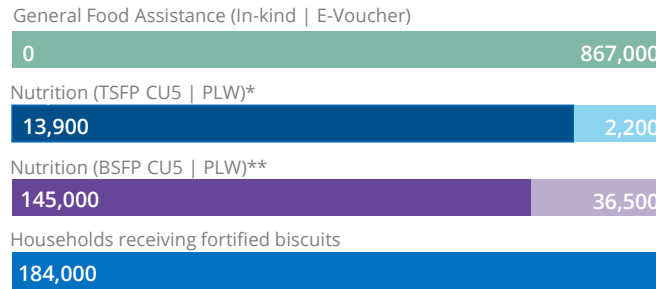


PEOPLE ASSISTED PER MONTH Bangladesh Rohingya Refugee Response

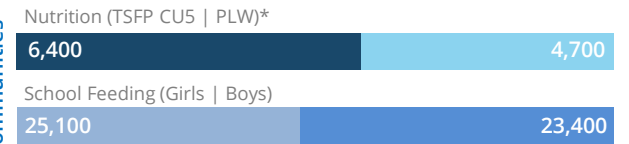

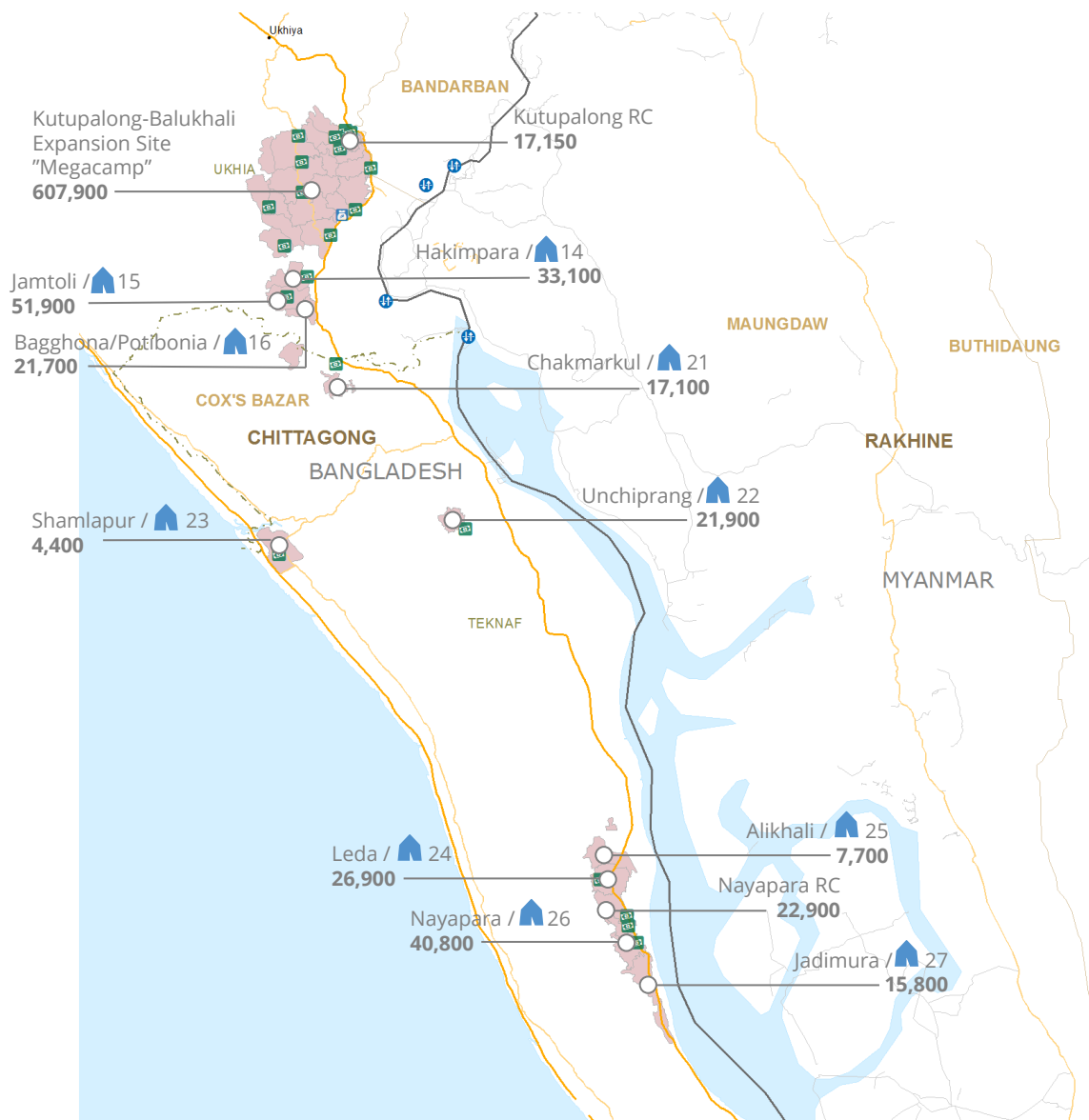

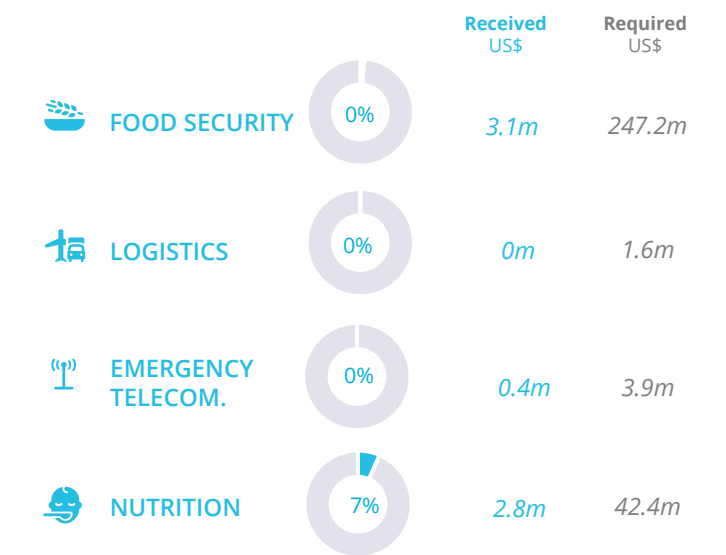
