

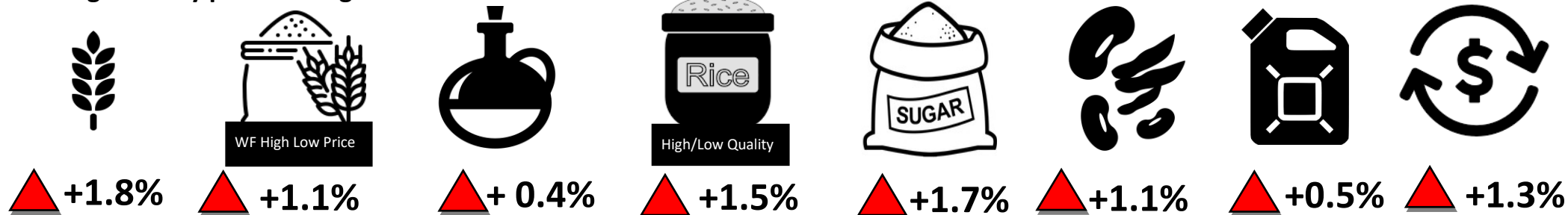


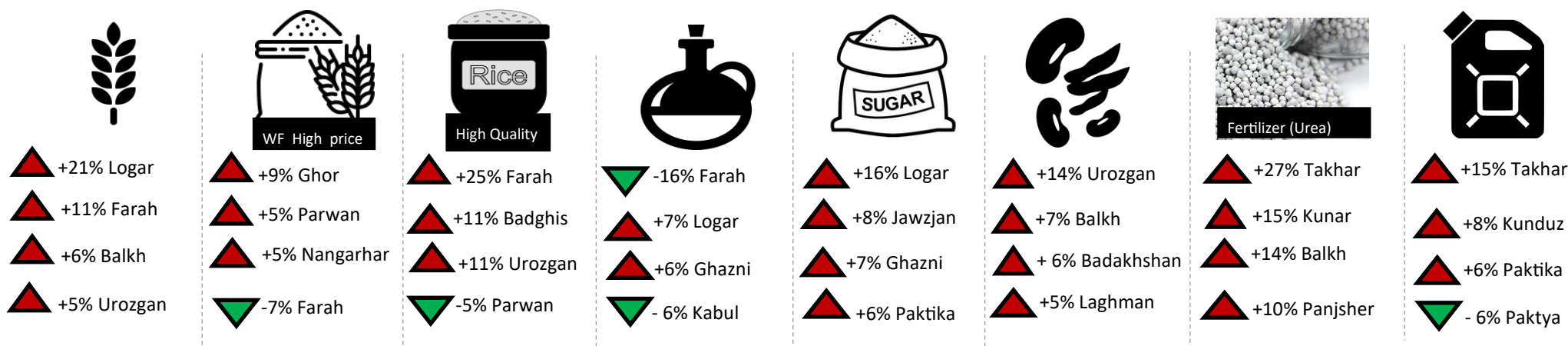
Highlights

- In the week 3 of November 2021, the prices of the food items were significantly higher than the last week of June (before the recent conflicts and political change).
- The price of most food items negligibly changed compared to the second week of November. Mainly due to decreased supply and Afghani currency devaluation.
- Both casual labour/wheat and pastoralist ToT slightly deteriorated by 2,0% and 1.7% respectfully as price of wheat went up.
- The price of fertilizer UREA and DAP continued to increase by 4.4% and 2.3% respectively due to high demand and decreased supply from source of point (Iran, Pakistan and Turkmenistan).
- Exchange rate continued to rise hitting a new record high at 93.8 AFN/USD.

Casual Labour/Wheat ToT

Casual labour/wheat ToT slightly declined by 2.0%. The weekly ToT remained 28.4 below the number of last week of June 2021, before recent conflicts and political changes.

This ToT declined in few provinces including Logar (18%), Farah (10%), Balkh, Jawzjan, Faryab, Samangan and Urozgan (5%), Hilmand (4%), Kunar, Bamyan and Daykundi (3%), due to increased in the price of wheat.

ToT improved only in Kandahar, due to decrease in the price of wheat .

Number of days work is available

The average number of days that work is available for casual workers declined this week by 4.0% and reached to 1.4 days per week which is 42.1% lower than the last week of June (before the recent conflicts and political change). No work opportunity in 4 provinces since fourth week of August in Daykundi, Logar, Paktya and Panjsher, Bamyan since 2nd week of September and now Badghis in 3rd week of November. At provincial level, the number declined only in Zabul 33% (from 3 to 2 days) due to less work opportunity.

Pastoralist ToT

The national average number of pastoralist ToT declined this week by 1.9%. This number is 20.9% below the number of the last week of June 2021. Increased wheat price contributed to the main driver of ToT deterioration in few provinces including Logar (18%), Farah (10%), Balkh, Jawzjan, Faryab, Samangan and Urozgan (5%), Hilmand (4%), Kunar, Bamyan and Daykundi (3%). The improvement occurred in Ghor (9%) and Kandahar (3%), due to increase of sheep price and decrease of wheat price respectfully.
