

Highlights

From 27 April to 22 July 2017, **384,719** suspected cholera cases and **1,858** deaths (CFR: **0.5%**) have been reported in **91.3% (21/23)** of Yemen governorates, and **88.6% (295/333)** of the districts.

Geographical distribution of cases

The **five** most affected governorates were Amanat Al Asimah, Al Hudaydah, Hajjah, Amran and Ibb with 53.5% (**205,933/384,719**) of the cases reported since 27 April 2017.

- Al Dhale'e, Al Mahwit and Amran governorates had the highest attack rates (**28.7‰, 28.3‰ and 25.7‰** respectively)
- Raymah ,Hajjah and Ibb governorates reported the highest case fatality ratios (**1.3% ,0.9% and 0.8%** respectively) (see table).

(Amanat Al Asimah governorate, 7,440 suspected cases and 11 deaths), and Al Hawak (Al Hudaydah governorate, 7,164 suspected cases and 11 deaths)
