



## Situation Report of Cholera Outbreak in Adamawa State Week 48: Reported on 4th December, 2018 Reporting period: 26<sup>th</sup> Nov – 2nd Dec, 2018 Adamawa State Ministry of Health



### Highlights:

- No new case was reported within the week.
- Total case count now stands at 2,755 with 41 deaths. CFR is 1.5%

### Epidemiological summary

The total number of cases reported as at 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2018 stands at 2,755 cases with 41 deaths (CFR=1.5%). Yola North has 264 cases with 6 deaths (CFR= 2.3%); Fufore has 687 cases with 7 deaths (CFR = 1.0%); Girei has 17 cases with no death (CFR=0%); Yola South has 51 cases with 1 death (CFR=2.0%); Hong has 9 cases with no death (CFR = 0%); Maiha has 170 cases with 1 death (CFR = 0.6%); Mubi North has 639 cases and 14 deaths (CFR=2.2%); while Mubi South has 918 cases with 12 deaths (CFR = 1.3%). 42 out of 73 culture samples taken yielded positive growth.

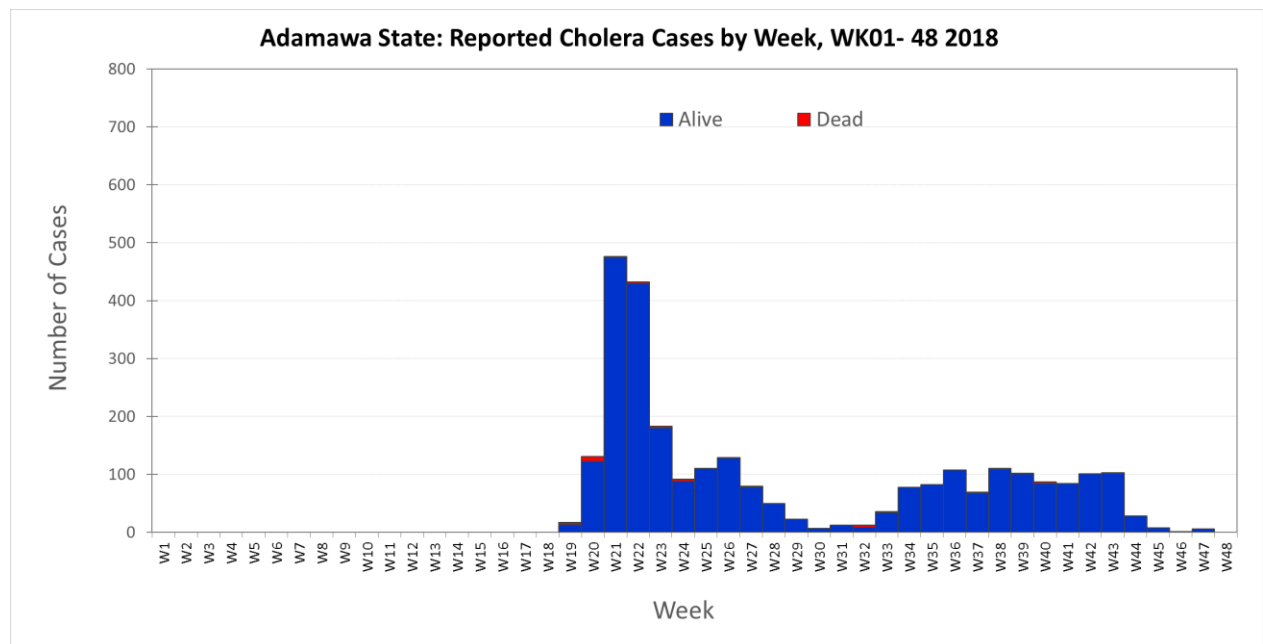


Fig1. Weekly trend of cholera cases, WK 1 – WK 48, 2018

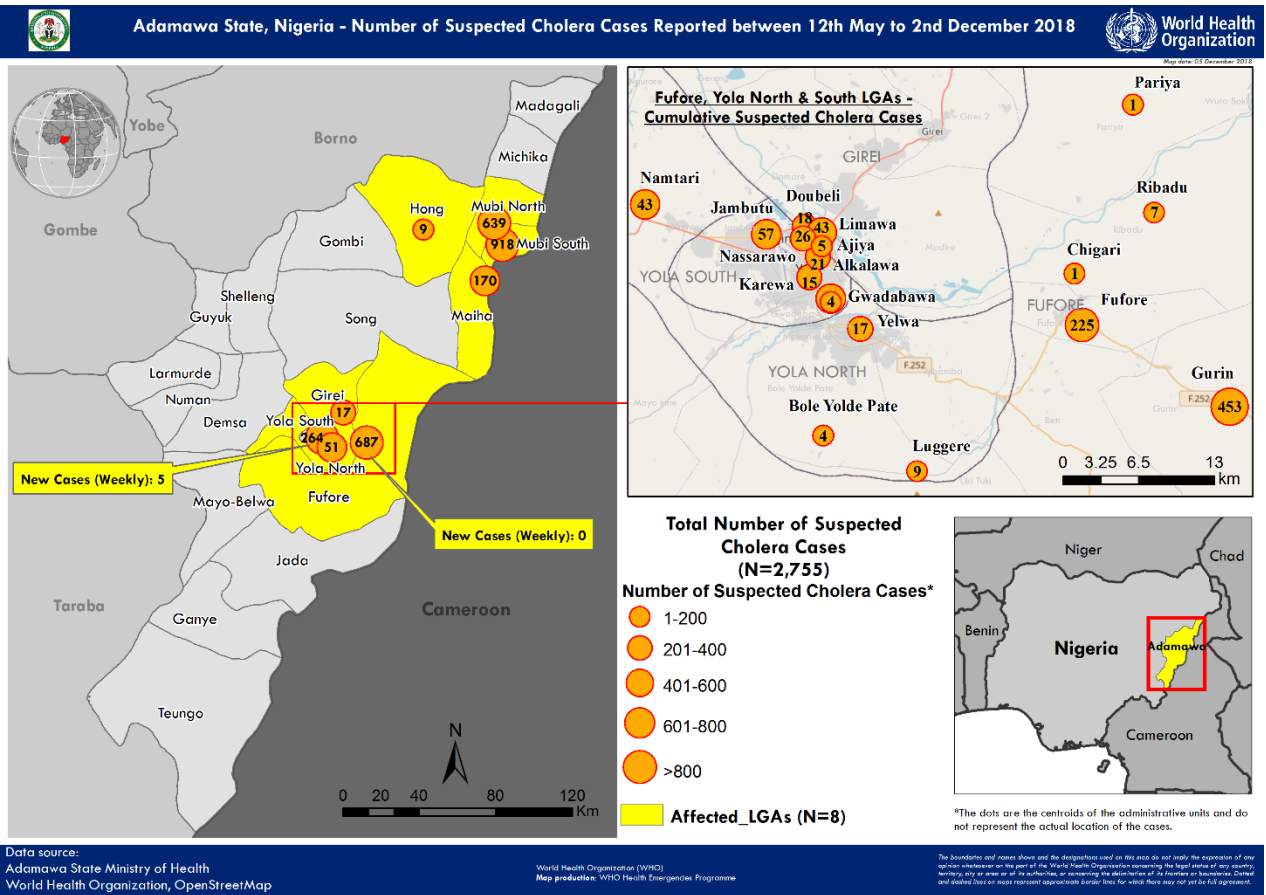


Fig 2. Map of Adamawa showing suspected cases of cholera

## Response

### 1. Coordination

- EOC coordination meeting now holds once a week.

### 2. Surveillance

- Active case search is still ongoing.
- 25 teams of volunteers supported by WHO conduct house to house search for new cases of suspected cholera in Yola North, Yola South and Girei.
- Active case search teams supported by WHO visited 4,050 households in 26 settlements of Girei, Yola North and Yola South LGAs
- 7 suspected cases were identified but non fit the case definition after review by health workers.
- Review meeting of ACS personnel was conducted and refresher training on case definition of cholera and risk communication were given

### 3. Case Management

- No patient was seen in CTC within the week.

- IRC supported the training of 60 community health volunteers from 10 communities in Limawa, Yelwa, Doubeli and Jambutu wards in Yola North LGA, Wuro Jabbe in Yola South LGA and Angwan Kara in Girei LGA

- IRC supported volunteers visited 1678 households and sensitized 11,746 persons.
