Highlights

- No new case was reported
- Total suspected case count now stands at 15 with 0 deaths (CFR=0 %)

Epidemiological Summary

The total number of cases reported as at 31st July 2021, stands at 15 cases with 0 deaths (CFR=0%), Girei has reported 5 cases with 0 deaths (CFR= 0%); Yola North has reported 6 suspected case with 0 death (CFR= 0%) while Yola South reported 4 suspected cases with 0 deaths (CFR= 0%). One of the 5 suspected cases from Girei has been confirmed positive for cholera by the reference lab Abuja. So far, only two samples tested positive by RDT and yielded growth suggestive of *Vibrio cholerae* on culture while the result of 1 isolate (Girei LGA) from the reference laboratory revealed 01 serotype.

COORDINATION

- Coordination meetings holding Tuesdays and Thursdays every week
- The health delegate of ICRC from Abuja was in the EOC and has pledged more support
- WHO has agreed with OCHA to escalate DRC restriction of deploying prepositioned commodities to the HCT
- ICRC delivered commodities to the CTC following WHO & Government advocacy for support from partners
- Reports are generated and shared to partners

PLANNED COORDINATION ACTIVITIES

- Follow up on the official declaration of outbreak by the SMOH

- WHO & SMOH to follow up with sister MDAs concerning synergy
- WHO to follow up with IRC concerning capacity building

SURVEILLANCE AND LABORATORY

- One case confirmed from Girei
- Yola North reported 2 suspected cases
- ACS is ongoing in Hotspots communities of Yola North, Yola South & Girei LGA
- 1,798 Households were visited by the 3 ACS teams in 7 hotspots communities of Yola North, Yola South & Girei LGA. 2 suspected cases were reported

Planned Activities

- Possibility of repurposing the hygiene promoters to support ACS & RCCE
- Continue to advocacy for scaling up more teams to support ACS
- DSNOs to update line-list of suspected cases

CASE MANAGEMENT

- 2 suspected cases were admitted in the CTC within the reporting period
- RDT were both negative for the 2 suspected cases
- No case on admission presently
- Most personnel in the CTC are contracted staff

Planned Activities

- Continue to advocate to partners to support personnel stipends in the CTC
- Preposition IVF, antibiotics, RDTs, Cary Blair, hand sanitizers and RRTs
- Train and re-train HCWs on case management in CTU and support them with logistics
- HCWs in the two priority LGAs to be trained on setting and running ORT Corners
- IPC to be strengthen at the CTU and ORT corners in collaboration with WASH

WASH

Water point Chlorination

- 64 chlorinators engaged by SI, NRC, IOM and ICRC conducting water point chlorination in 32 water points in Girei and Yola North LGAs.
- 40 House-to-House Hygiene Promoters engaged by SI, NRC, IOM and ICRC and are conducting hygiene promotions in communities in Girei and Yola North LGAs.
- Disinfection of Household latrines and public dump sites by IOM and NRC ongoing in communities of Girei and Yola North LGAs.
- Distribution of IEC materials and Aquatabs at households by ICRC ongoing.
- Radio jingles on prevention of cholera by IRC and ICRC ongoing.

GAPS:

- No residual household spraying
- Environmental sanitation yet to be carried out in affected communities

PLANNED WASH ACTIVITIES

- Follow up on partners who made verbal commitment
- ES of affected LGs to carry out advocacy visits to opinion leaders on the need for community cohesion for sanitation in the communities

- WASH coordinator to identify partners that will carry out water source mapping and situation profiling in affected communities.
- WASH coordinator to mobilize partners in the sector who will carry out water chlorination and supportive supervision at identified water sources prone to contamination.
- WASH coordinator to ensure that hygiene promoters are engaged and functioning within the affected communities in the coming weeks.

SOCIAL MOBILIZATION

- WHO has supplied IEC materials for inter-personal health education
- The State Ministry is yet to officially declare the outbreak in the State

PLANNED ACTIVITIES FOR SOCIAL MOBILIZATION

- Working with the surveillance & coordination pillars for possible use of hygiene promoters to support RCCE

LOGISTICS

- ICRC has donated commodities to support IPC & Case management in the CTC
- LMCU have been contacted to assist with commodity mobilization and tracking from partners
