### Note on interpretation:

Data is sourced from end-of-day incident reports from Site Management Support agencies, compiled by the Site Management Sector with technical support from IOM Needs and Population Monitoring (NPM).

Data cleaning and verification is done daily, and continues in the days after; cumulative numbers may therefore be slightly adjusted to reflect new verifications or reports received. The detailed daily report section reflects incidents reported on that day, up to the 18:00 deadline. Any incident reports received after the deadline are included in the following day's cumulative numbers, and are fully reflected on the online map.

All numbers are indicative, from rapid on-the-day assessment intended to inform mobilization of first response.

Cumulative data on affected infrastructure is compiled by individual Sectors, with daily incident data verified by partners on the ground as needed. Cumulative affected infrastructure numbers are available in the weekly ISCG EMPRTF report, available [here](#).

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
