

As of the 13 July 2021 an estimated 104,635 people have been displaced from Palma. IDPs continue to arrive in Nangade on foot and by bus from Nangade to Mueda, Montepuez, and Pemba.

The CCCM cluster continues to work in close collaboration with the National Institute for Disaster Management and Risk Reduction (INGD) to provide logistical and technical support including:

- a) Monitoring of transit center at Centro Desportivo, Pemba
- b) Monitoring IDPs arrivals across 16 sites in districts Metuge, Montpuez, Chiure, and Ancuabe through CCCM partners.

Centro Desportivo Transit Site Overview

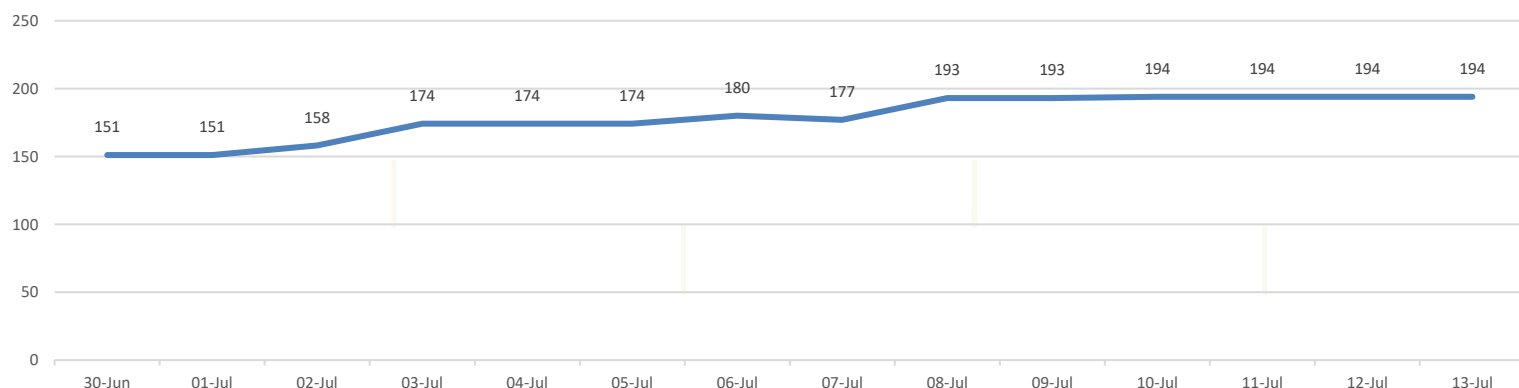








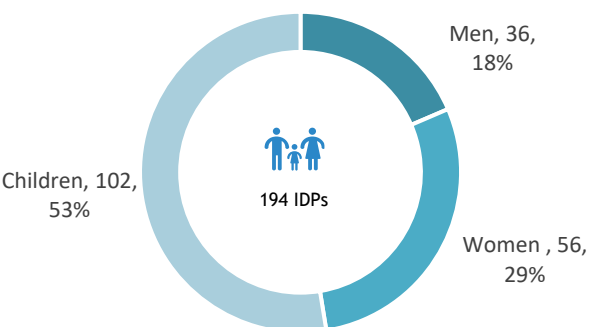


Chart 1: Centro Desportivo Transit Site Population

The Government has established a transit center at the Sports Centre complex in Pemba. The Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM) cluster continues to support the INGD in the management and improvement of the site.

The sports complex has a capacity to accommodate nearly 400 individuals at the Sphere Standard of 3.5 m² per person.

The population of the transit center has doubled in the past weeks due to an influx of displaced people by boat and road. There are currently 194 individuals, with an increase in vulnerable populations of elderly and unaccompanied or separated children. Discussions are ongoing for options for the remaining families living inside the center.
