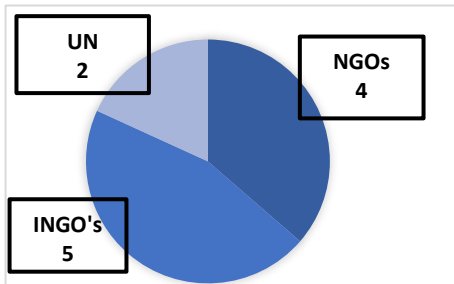

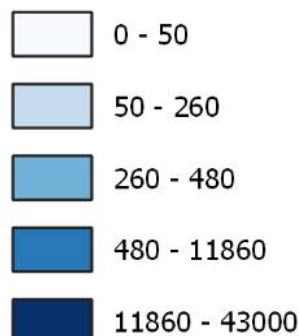

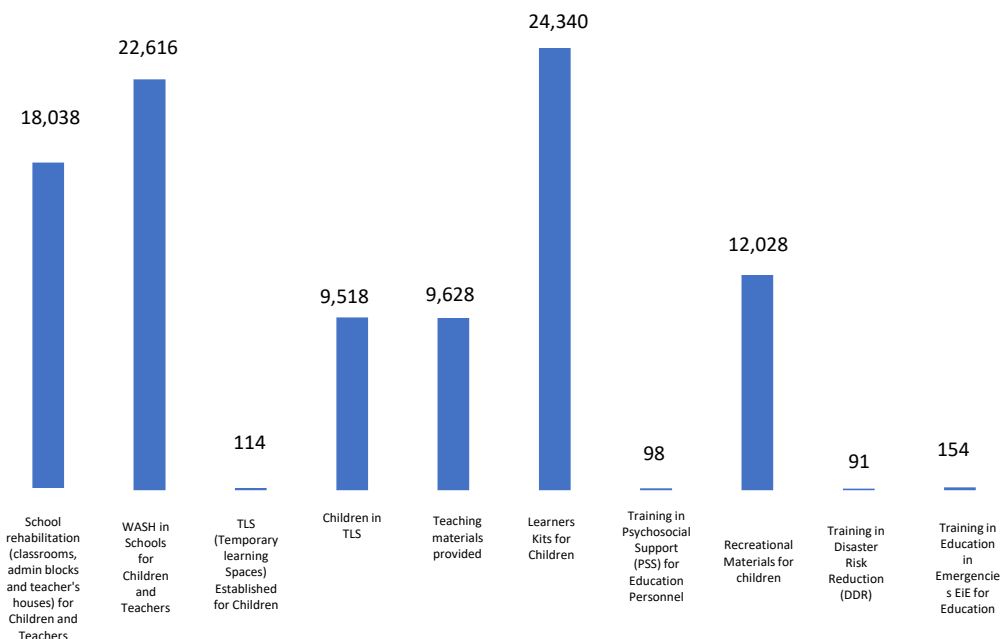
Nearly 900 teachers have been affected by Cyclone Kenneth (either displaced or lost property) thus require humanitarian assistance. Initial target is 897
