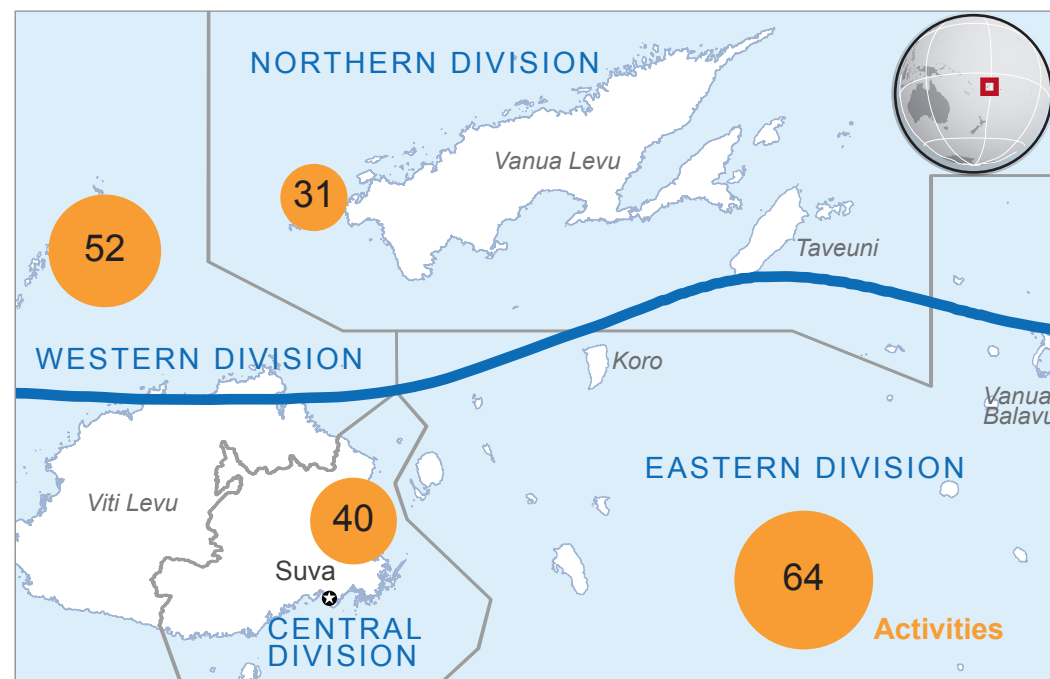


Who does What Where database

Information on humanitarian activities was collected from partners in Fiji. The information in that database and on this infographic provides a broad overview of humanitarian activities in response to TC Winston.

An 'activity' is considered as one agency, doing one activity in one province. Since most activities are done at the village level, the numbers in the table at right, should not be considered the number of distributions or interventions, but rather the number of agencies, implementing different activities in the different provinces per division.

It must also be noted that this database only contains information we received. It is assumed there are more activities taking place in this response than what is reflected here. Also if information was received but the cluster, location, or activity was not specified, it was not included into the database. Activities such as assessments, and coordination were also not included.
