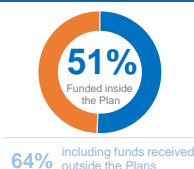


Figures in US\$ ■ Plan Funding ■ Unmet Requirement ■ Outside Plan Funding

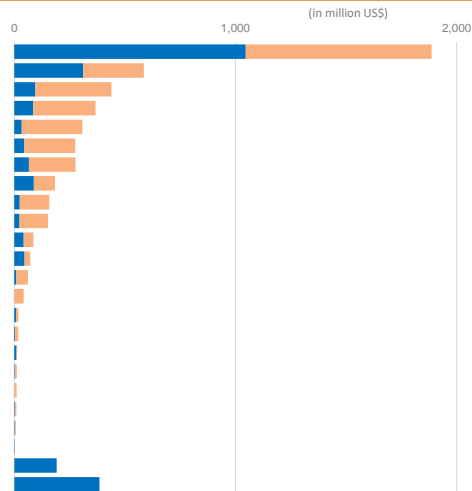
