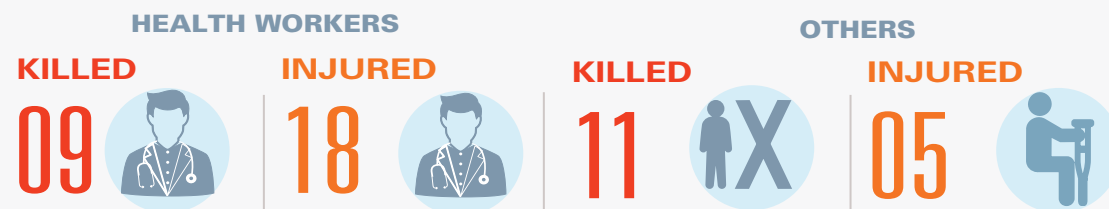

NUMBER OF ATTACKED FACILITIES



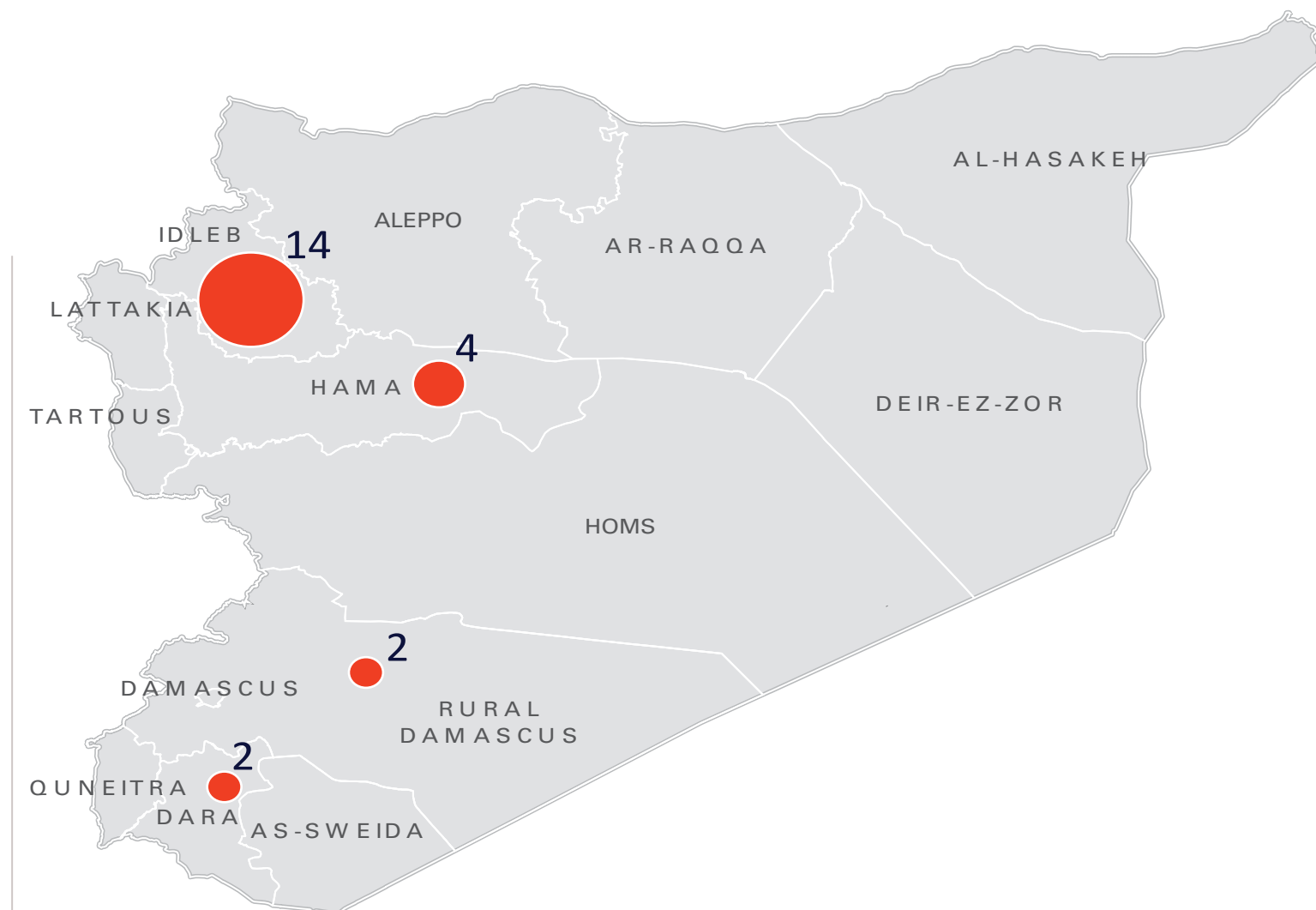
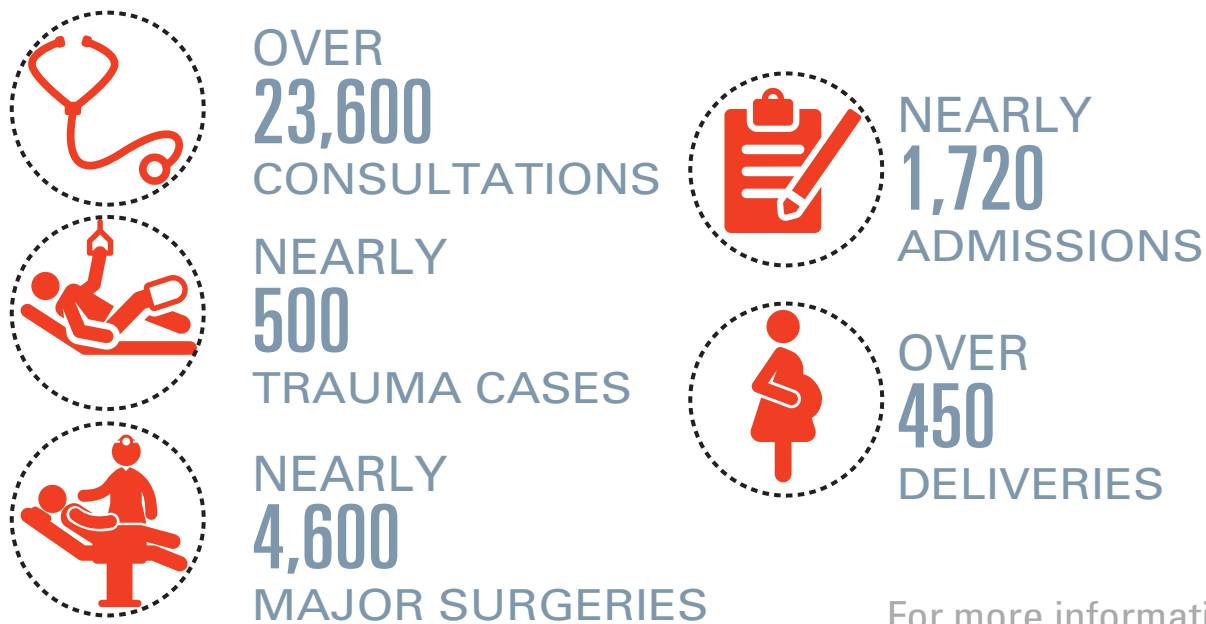
SUMMARY

During April 2017, 29 incidents of violence against health care were reported. Of these, 22 have been verified and seven are still being verified. Among the verified attacks, 20 incidents were identified on health care structures, including three hospitals specialized in surgery and maternity and two medical units were destroyed. The highest number of the incidents were reported from Idleb governorate with 14 attacks followed by northern Hama countryside with four attacks and two attacks each in Dar'a and Rural Damascus. In Idleb, seven hospitals (one hospital was attacked twice on two different occasions), including two specialized hospitals, three primary health care centers, two medical points and one ambulance system center were attacked, at least ten ambulances were lost during one attack. In Hama, three hospitals and one ambulance center were attacked. In Dar'a, one hospital was attacked and a laboratory technician was killed on the road between Abtaa and Sheikh Maskin cities. In Rural Damascus, a hospital was attacked and one paramedic was killed in air strikes.

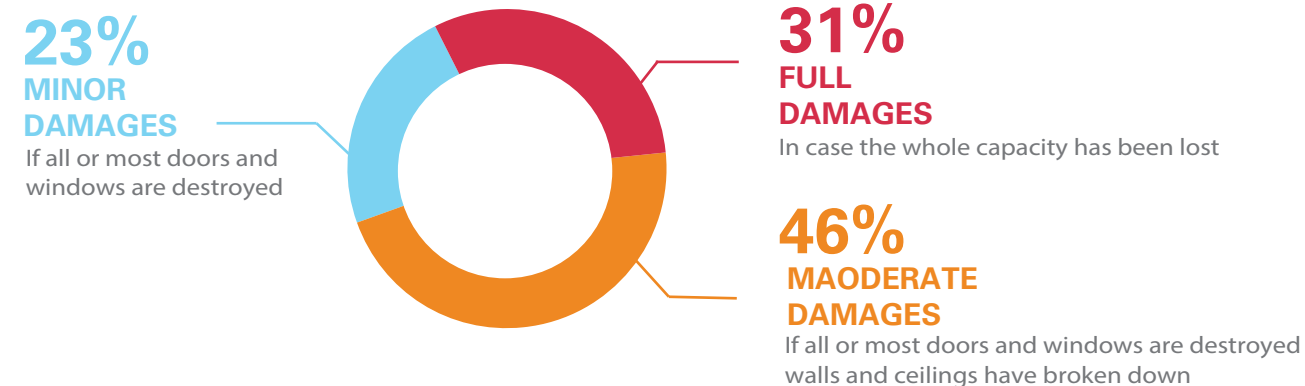
Collectively these attacks resulted in the killing of at least 20 people, including nine health workers, six of them in Idleb, two in Dar'a and one in Rural Damascus, and injuring at least 23 people, including 18 health workers 14 in Idleb, two in Hama and two in Rural Damascus, more numbers are under verification.
