(updated from the FR_EDUCATION 27.09.2020 data)

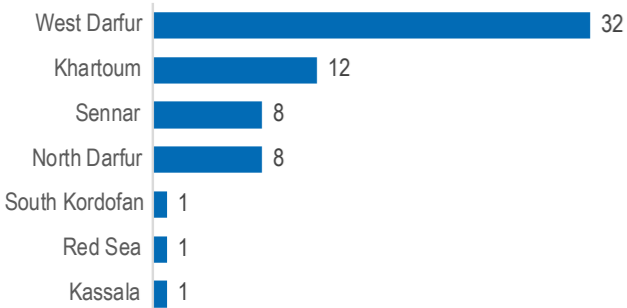
More than one hundred and thirty thousand children are now at risk of not being able to return to school when schools reopen on November 22, 2020 (October 11 for grades 8 and 11 students). Children's education has already faced serious disruption due to COVID19-related school closures, which has resulted in significant learning losses, and is now at risk of further interruption due to floods.

63 Schools Used as Shelter



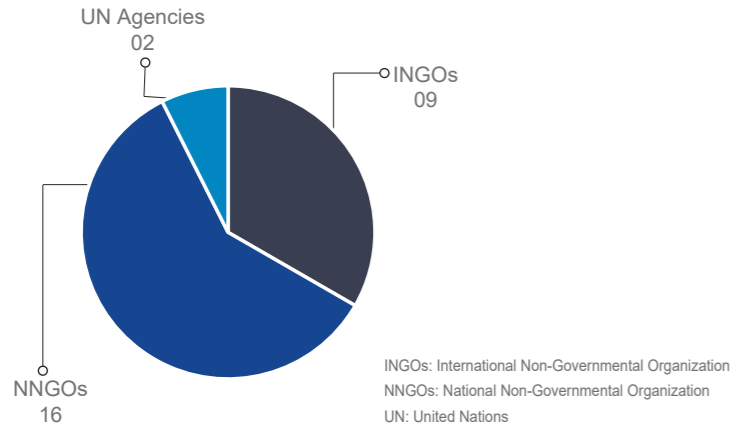
At the time of publication, 63 schools were reported as hosting flood-affected displaced persons seeking shelter. If these schools are not vacated prior to school resumption, tens of thousands of children will face prolonged disruption to their learning.

of partners by organisation type

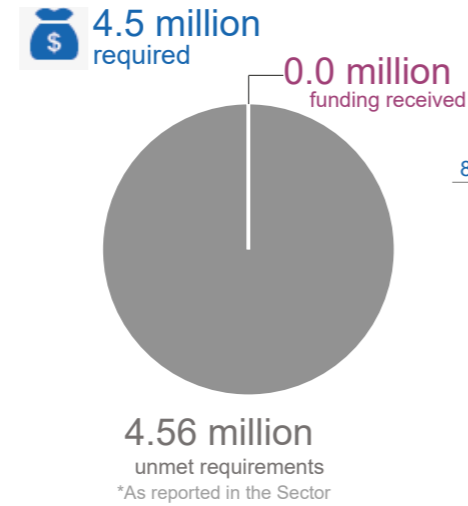


559 Schools damaged



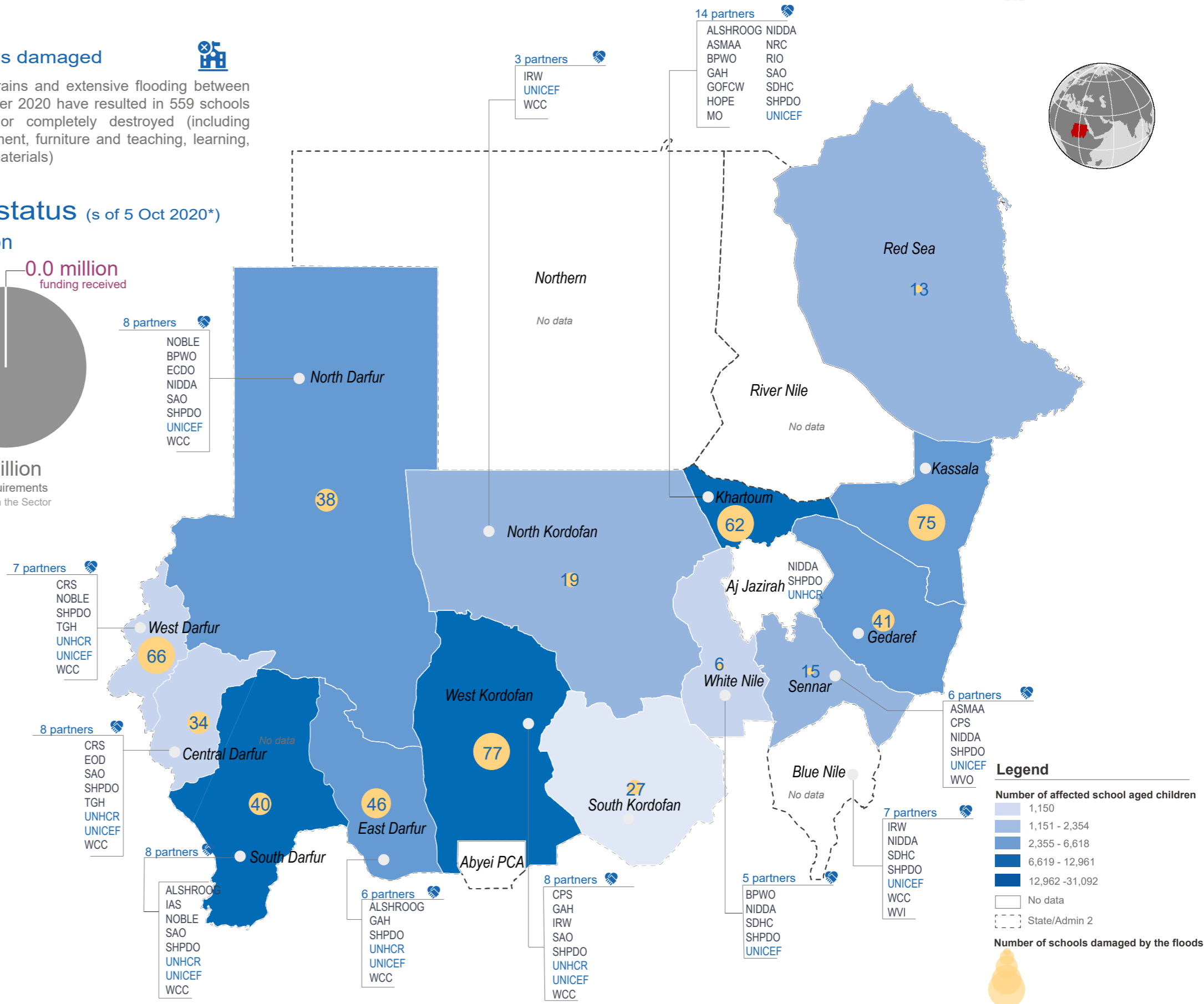
Unusually heavy rains and extensive flooding between July and September 2020 have resulted in 559 schools being damaged or completely destroyed (including damage to equipment, furniture and teaching, learning, and recreational materials)

Prioritized Sector Activities

1. Provision of Temporary Learning Spaces
2. Rehabilitation of classrooms and latrines
3. Replacement of damaged furniture and equipment
4. Replacement of student, teacher and recreation kits
