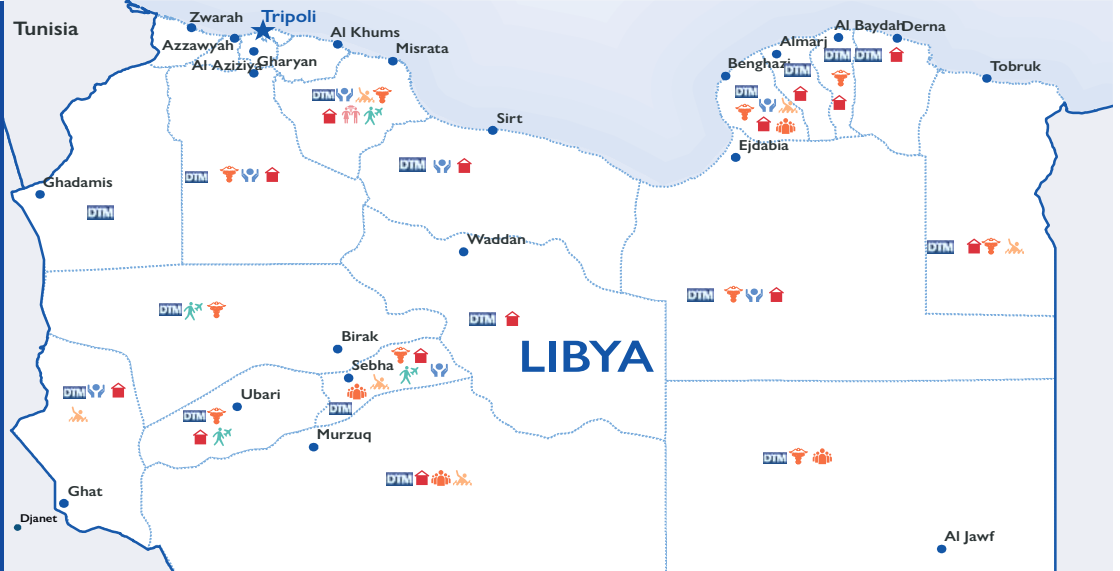

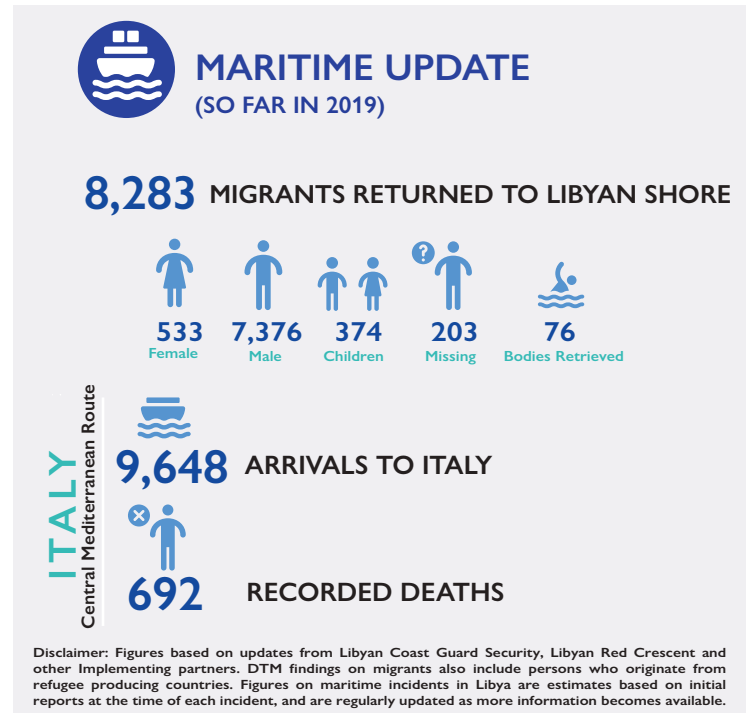
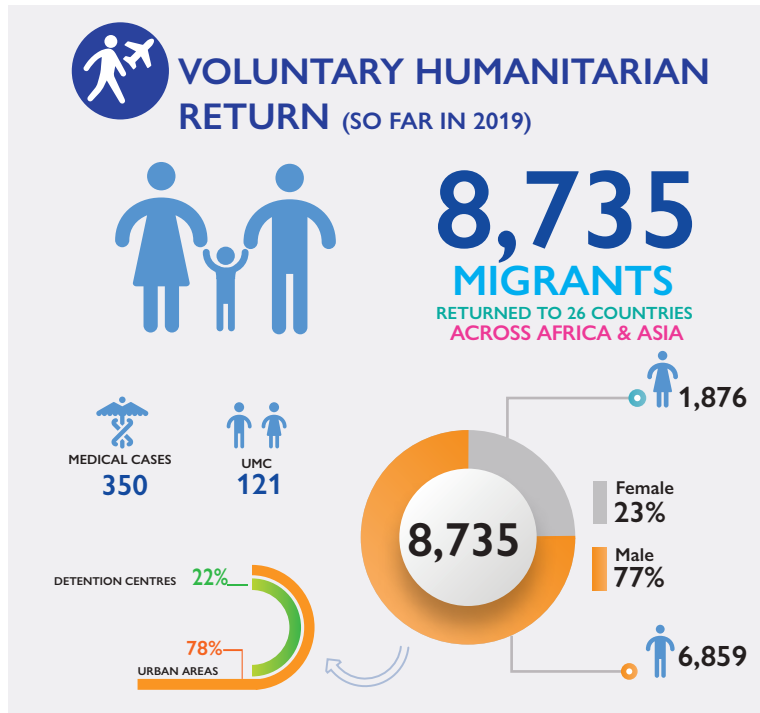

ASSISTANCE TO MIGRANTS AND LIBYAN COMMUNITIES

16-31 October

- The **Protection** team carried out 50 protection assessments (32 male and 18 female), including 14 child protection assessments. In this period, 11 hygiene and clothing kits were distributed to protection beneficiaries. A joint counselling session was held at IOM Tripoli Office for 5 cases.
- The **Health** unit provided 1,456 migrants with primary and urgent health care. The team referred also 9 migrants to hospitals and private clinics. Additionally, 1 workshop and 1 regional Roundtable Meeting on Migration Health were organized for 45 participants from 8 countries.
- The **Community Stabilization** unit have started the implementation phase for two new projects, including the rehabilitation of 2 football fields in Kufra, the drilling of 2 water wells in Qatroun. They also supplied and installed the final components of equipment for the Mitiga Dormitory at Sabha University. The team in Sabha distributed business toolkits for 9 entrepreneurs.
