



The Jordan Humanitarian Fund (JHF) mobilizes and channels resources to humanitarian partners to respond to urgent needs for Syrian refugees in Jordan, as well as vulnerable Jordanians affected by the Syrian crisis. The fund operates within the frame of the Jordan Response Plan and the UNSC resolutions 2165, 2191, 2258 and 2332.

To date the Fund has allocated US\$6.1 million to a total of 20 projects in host communities and camps, of which 9 projects support the needs of vulnerable Syrians in Southern Syria.

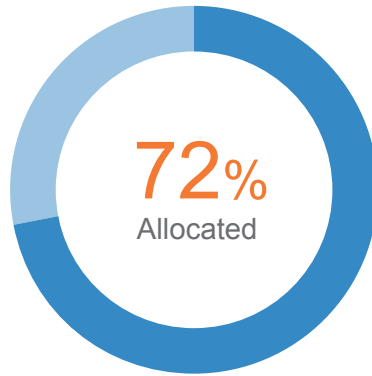

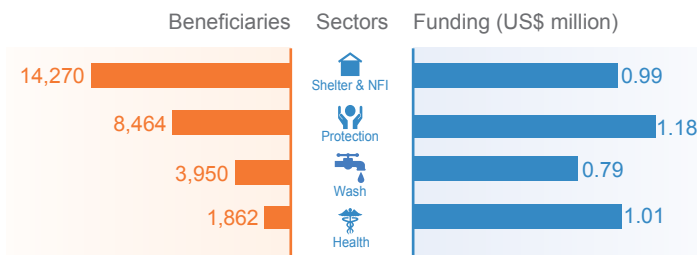

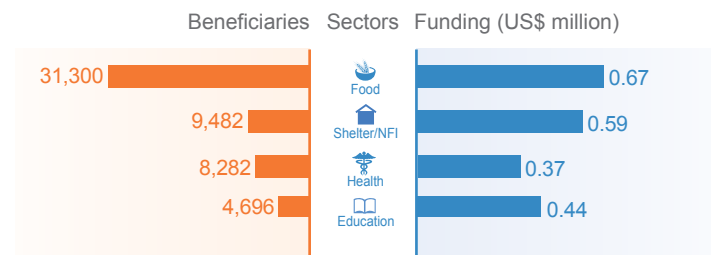

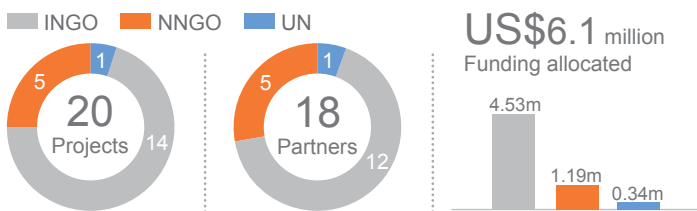
FUNDS AND BENEFICIARIES BY SECTORS FOR JORDAN



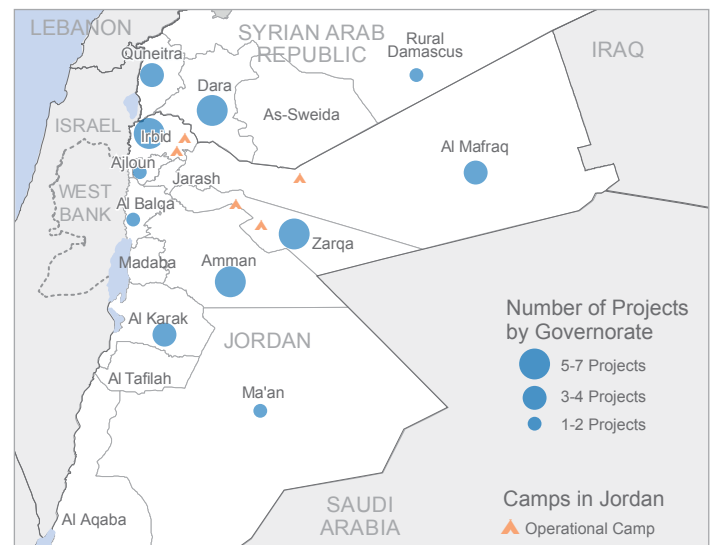
FUNDS AND BENEFICIARIES BY SECTORS FOR SOUTHERN SYRIA



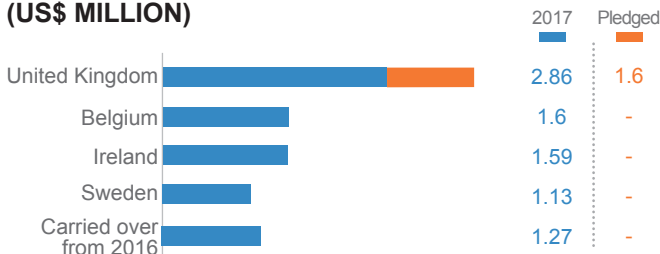
NUMBER OF PROJECTS BY PARTNERS
