

Highlights:

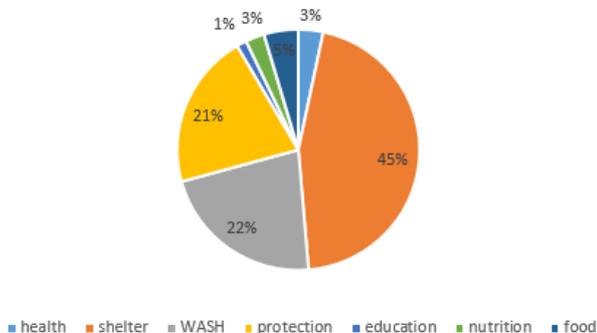
- In February, the Logistics Cluster coordinated two Inter-Agency Humanitarian Convoys to hard-to-reach areas, in close collaboration with SARC and OCHA.
- Much needed humanitarian supplies were transported to this location on behalf of five organisations.
- As part of the airlift operation between Damascus and Qamishli, 46 flights were conducted in February, delivering both food and non-food items to the city.
- 10,000 litres of WFP-procured diesel were provided to UNHCR while 10,000 litres of diesel were provided to IMC and ICRC on a cost-recovery basis.



Transport and Storage

- In February 2017, as part of the Inter-Agency Humanitarian Convoys, 3,608 m³ of relief cargo was transported to ar-Rastan and Talbiseh in Homs Governorate including Food, Health, Nutrition and WASH items.
- The Logistics Cluster has also facilitated the transport to and from accessible and secure locations inside Syria on a cost-recovery basis of 650 m³ of much needed Protection, Shelter, WASH, Health, Nutrition and Education supplies on behalf of ICRC, IOM, UNFPA, UNHCR and UNICEF.
- In February, 46 airlift rotations were conducted from Damascus to Qamishli, transporting 3,363 m³ of much needed humanitarian supplies on behalf of WFP, UNHCR and UNICEF.
- In addition, the Logistics Cluster stored 1,303 m³ of newly received humanitarian goods in its common storage facilities in Homs, Qamishli, Lattakia and Rural Damascus on behalf of IMC, IOM, Norwegian Refugee Council, Oxfam and UNICEF.
