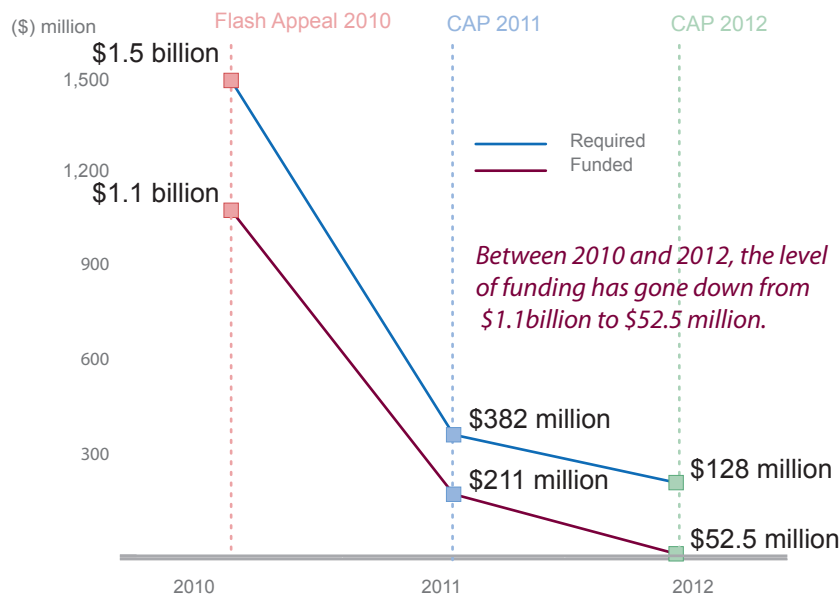
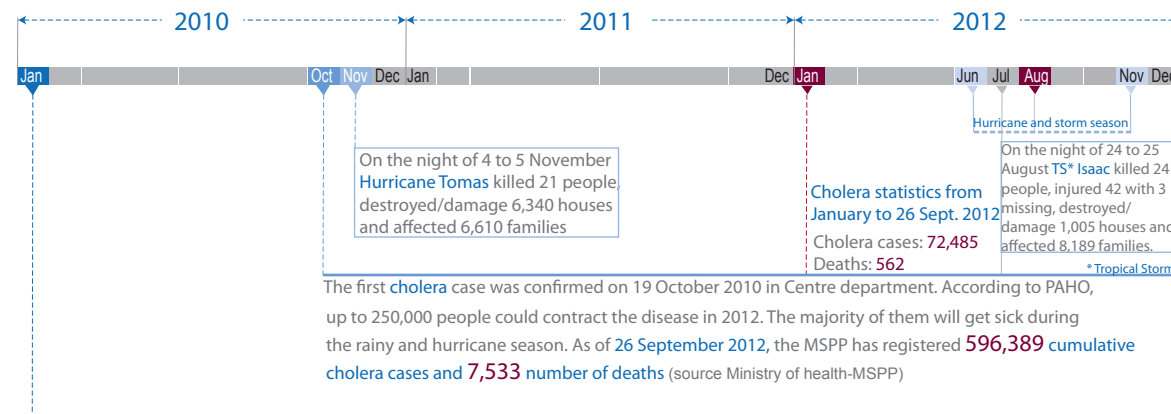

Event Timeline in Haiti



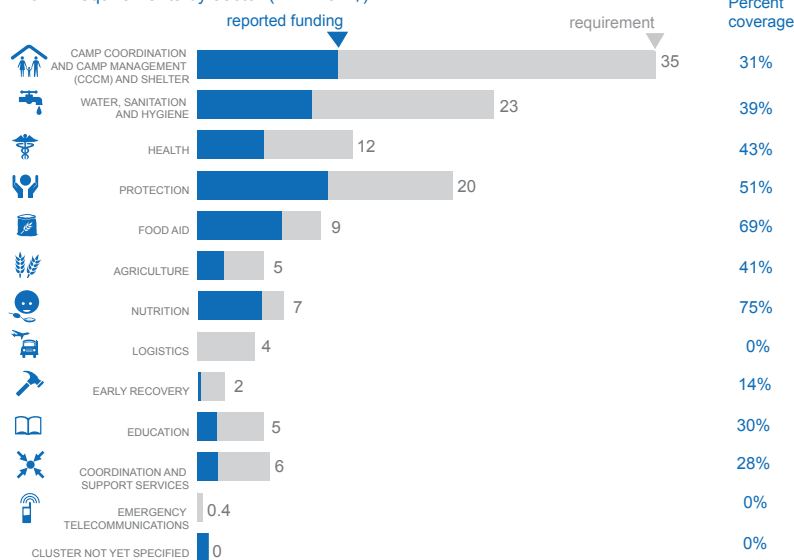
The first cholera case was confirmed on 19 October 2010 in Centre department. According to PAHO, up to 250,000 people could contract the disease in 2012. The majority of them will get sick during the rainy and hurricane season. As of 26 September 2012, the MSPP has registered 596,389 cumulative cholera cases and 7,533 number of deaths (source: Ministry of health-MSPP)

The earthquake that occurred on 12 January had displaced more than 2.1 million people and destroyed/damaged about 175,682 homes. More than 217,300 people were killed and 300,600 injured. According to the Camp Coordination and Camp management/Shelter Cluster, 320,000 individuals exposed to natural disasters, violence and Cholera epidemic will remain in the camps at the end of 2012. As of August 2012, there are 369,353 IDPs (93,748 Households) in 541 camps in Haiti (Source: Data Tracking Matrix - Cluster CCCM/Shelter)

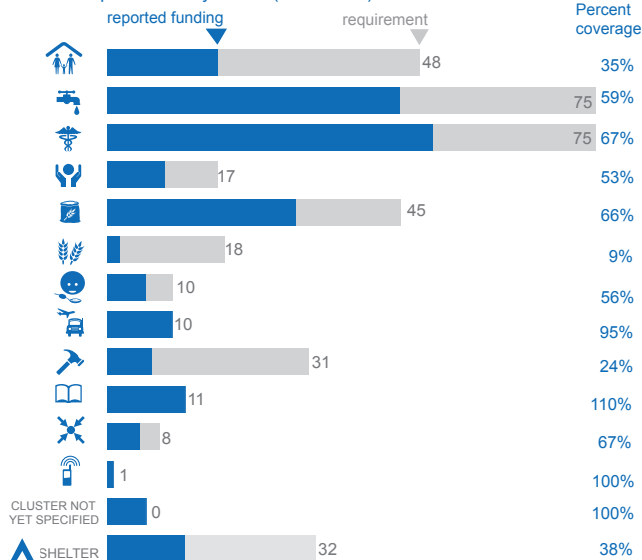
2012 Requirements by sector (in million \$)
