26,709 Children Supported in TLS

Out of this, 15,986 are boys & 15,711 girls IDP children have been supported to return to learning following their displacement.

These resumed education following the re-opening of 30 schools in Eastern Mosul with partners support.

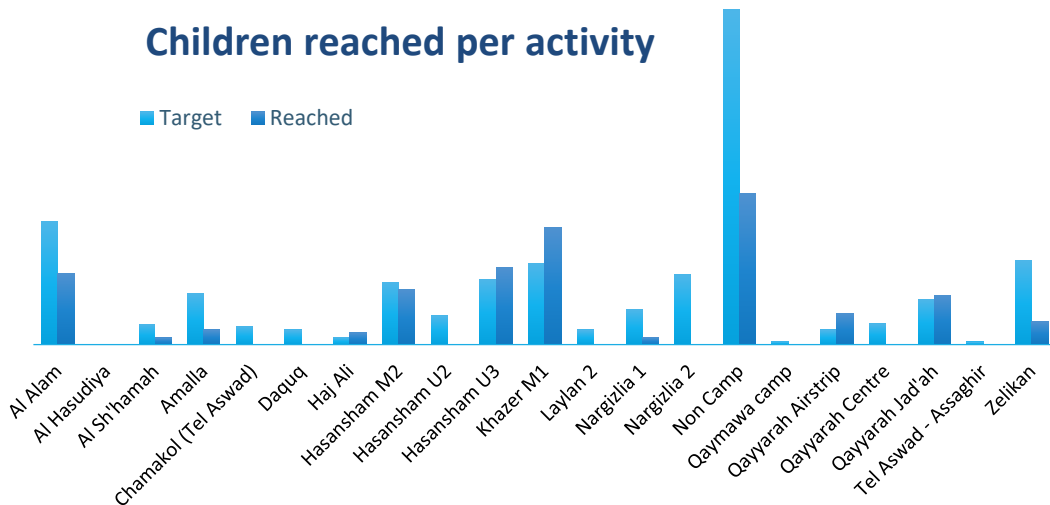

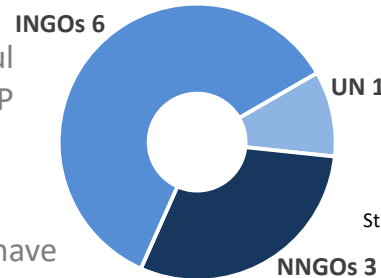
Displaced school-aged children in camps are not accessing any form of education activities due to funding gaps

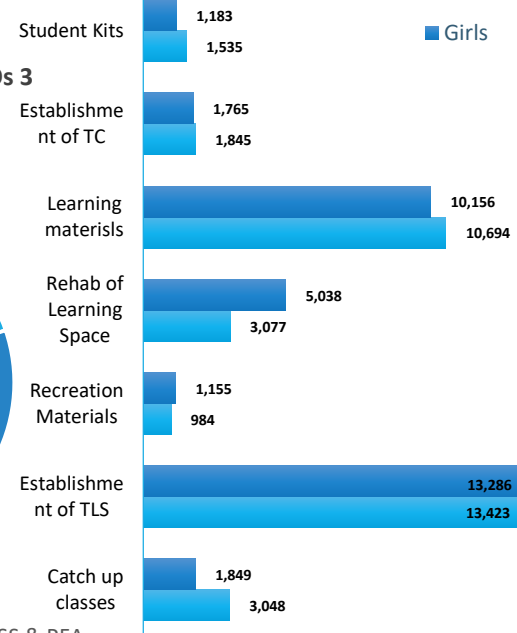

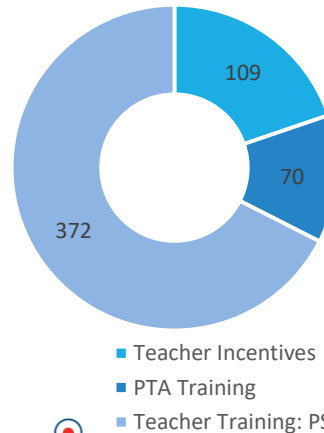

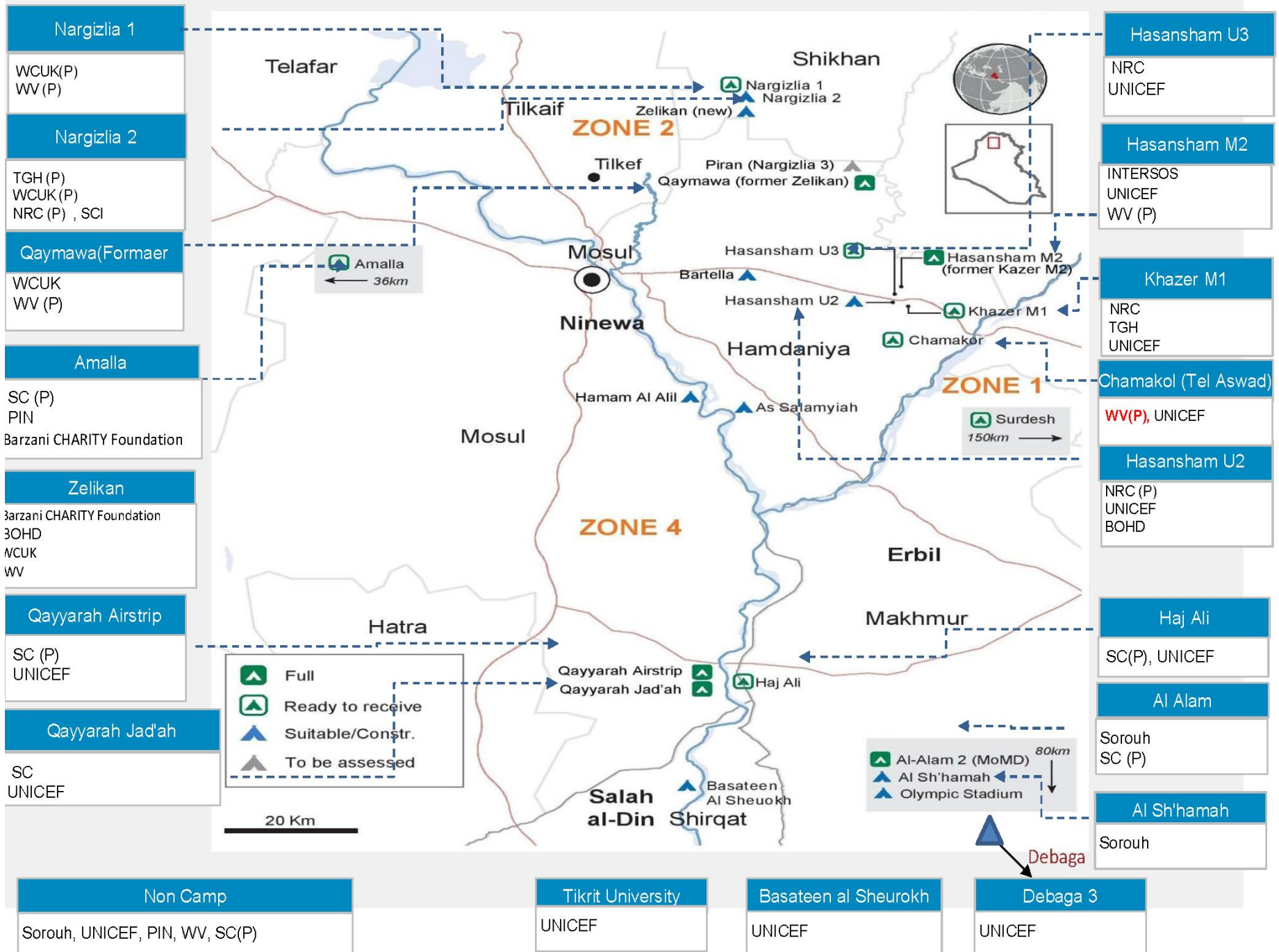


Challenges
