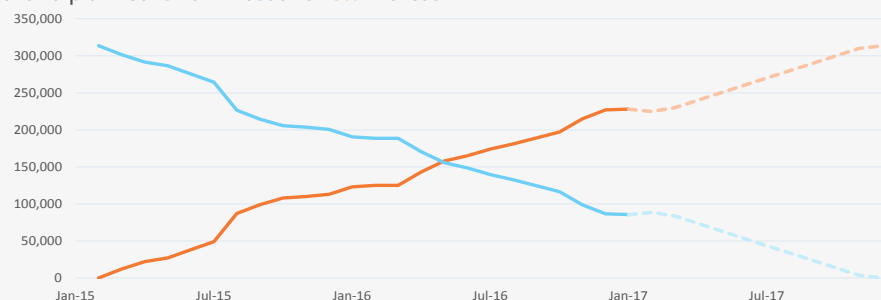


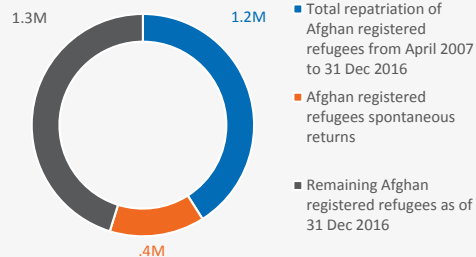
The Humanitarian Strategic Plan addresses the needs of 2.23 million people in Pakistan. In 2017, the humanitarian partners will support 0.14 million people that have been displaced from FATA, .48 million IDPs that have returned to FATA, 1.34 million registered Afghan refugees, and 0.27 million malnourished children and women.

In addition, humanitarian partners will support the Government with disaster preparedness and coordination.

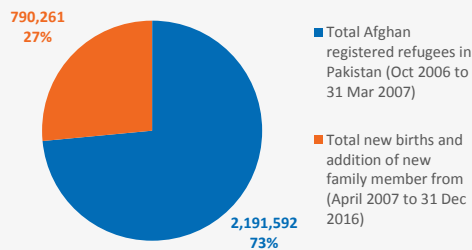
Actual and planned IDPs in host and return areas



Voluntary Afghan refugee returns

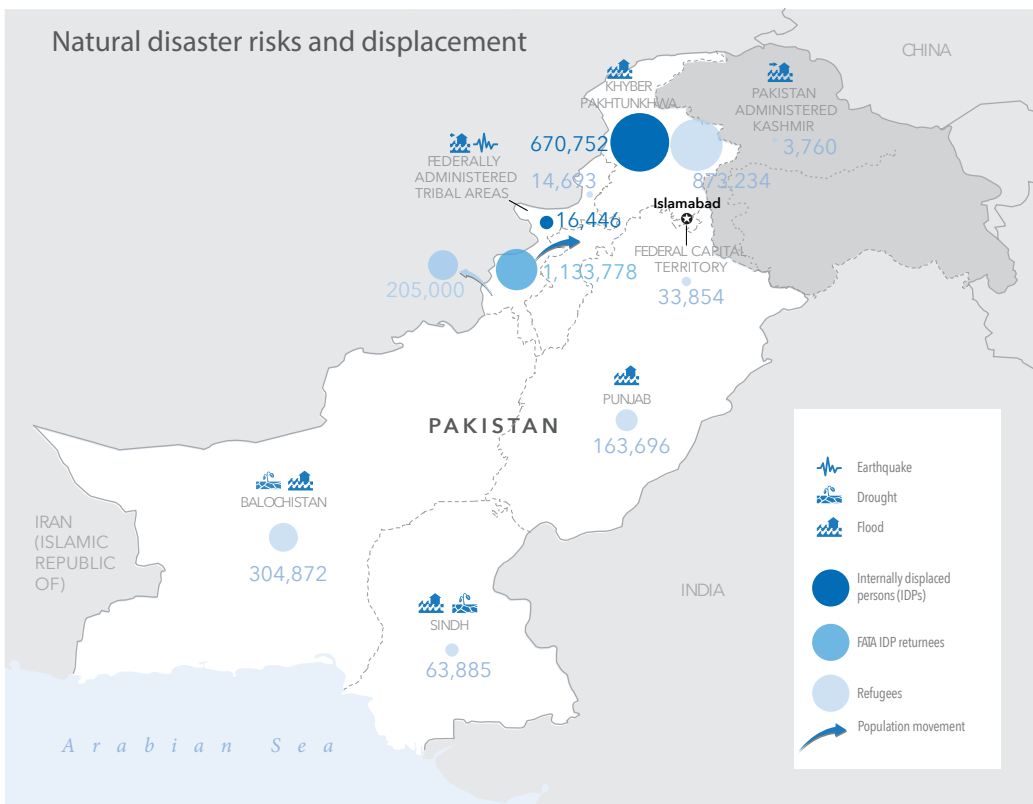


Afghan registered refugees population



Strategic objectives of the humanitarian community in Pakistan in 2017

- Support the humanitarian and protection needs of IDPs that remain displaced and those that have returned, ensuring a smooth transition to longer-term recovery and development
- Ensure protection, provide assistance and seek lasting solutions for Afghan refugees in Pakistan
- Reduce rates of acute malnutrition among children under five years, and pregnant and lactating women in disaster affected areas
- Strengthen humanitarian preparedness for a coordinated and effective response at local, provincial and national levels
