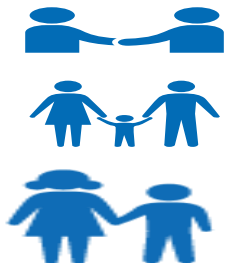

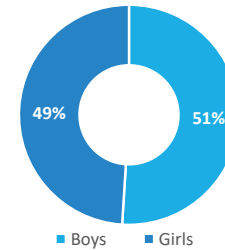
**7** partners are responding in Anbar Governorate as October 2017.

**189,785** children are targeted in Anbar in the 2017 HRP

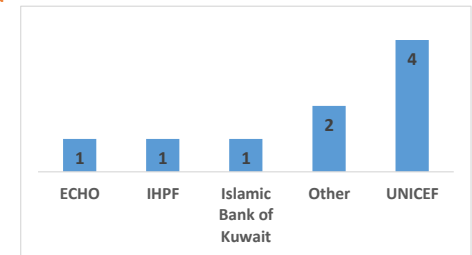
**172,887** children have been reached in Anbar with EiE as October 2017

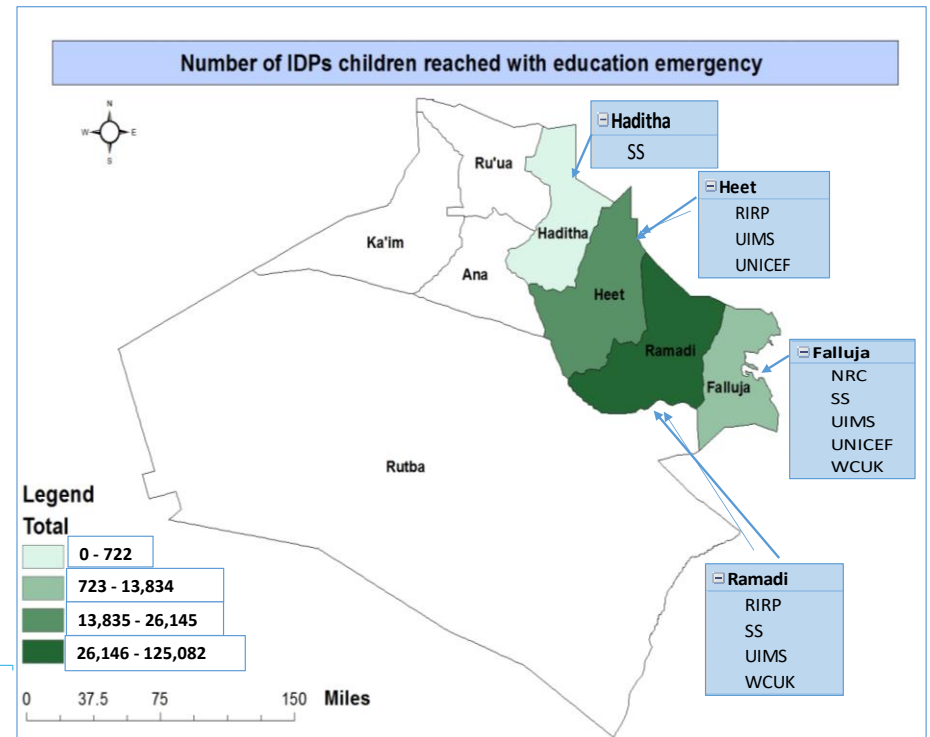
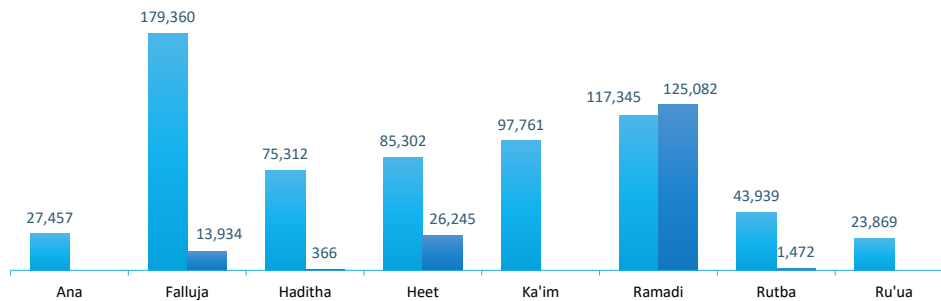

## Major EIE Activity Progress as October 2017



7 EIE partners are responding in 5 Districts in Anbar Governorate as October 2017



949 TLS (Tents/Prefabs/Rented spaces) have been set up in Ramadi ,Falluja and Heet districts in Anbar Governorate. So far 34,974 children (50% females) have accessed these spaces.



32,381 learners (50% females) have been provided with learning materials. 66% of the response happened in Falluja District



763 (52% females) teachers and other Education officials have been trained in Falluja , Haditha and Ramadi Districts.

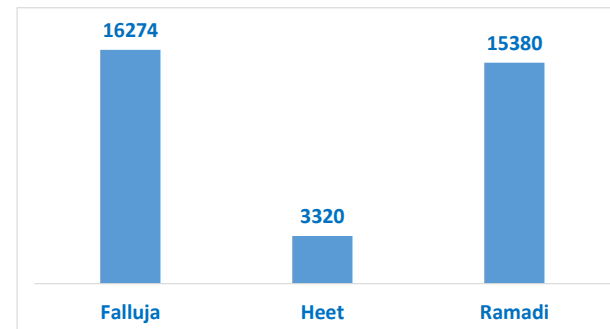


To date 2,697 classrooms have been rehabilitated, in Anbar Governorate. These have so far accomodated 169,411 children (43% females) mostly in Ramadi District.

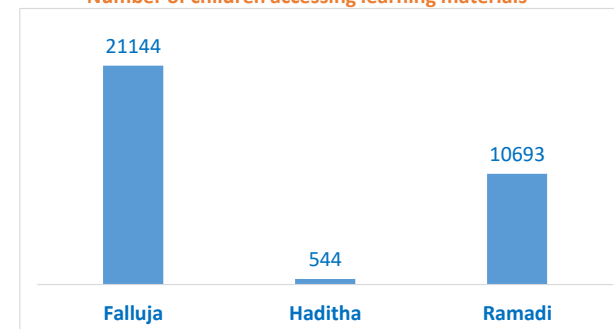


7,209 children (50.3% females), have been reached with psychosocial support services in learning spaces in Anbar Governorate. 100% of the PSS response is happening in Falluja District.
