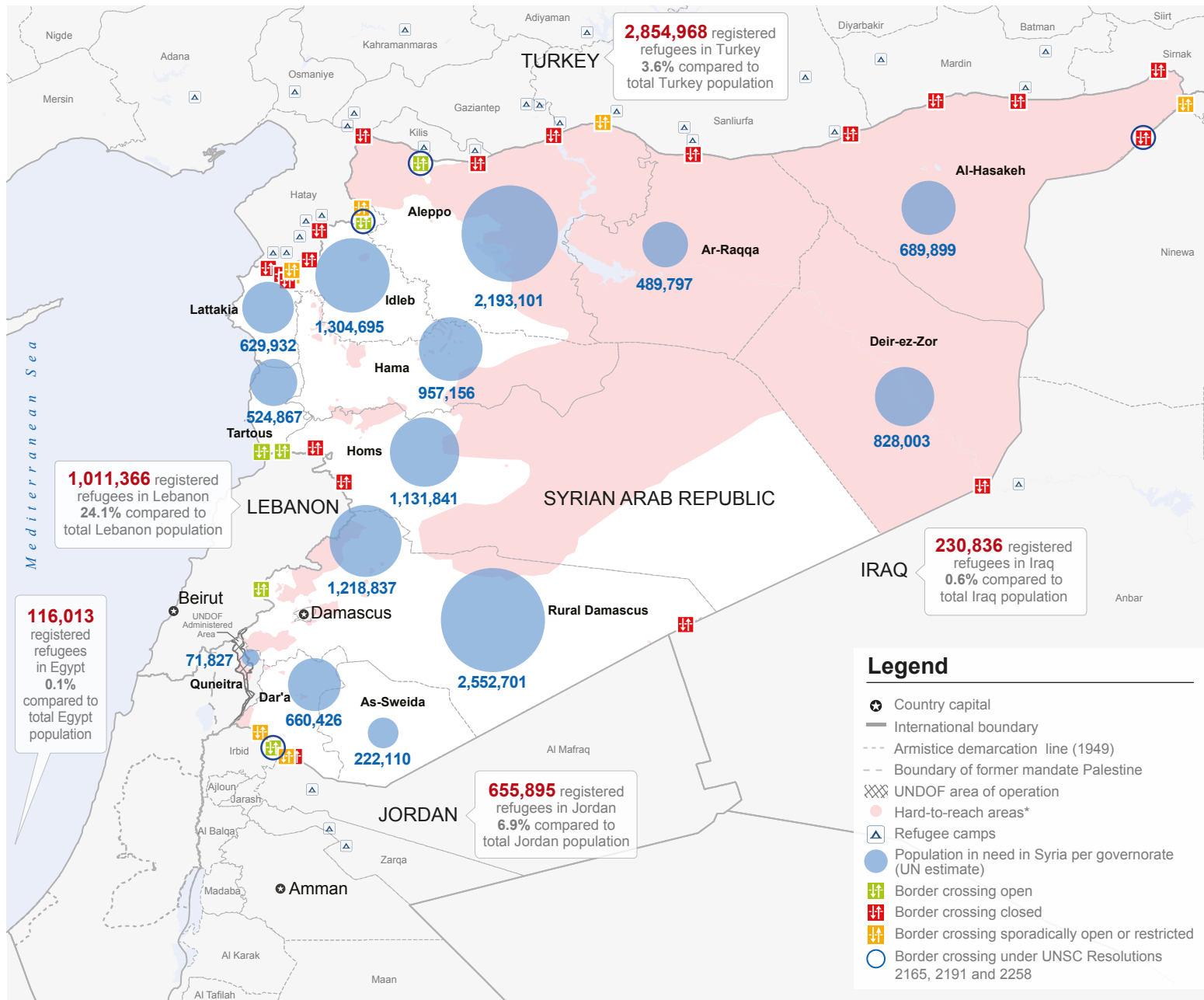


Syrian Arab Republic: Humanitarian Snapshot (as of 31 January 2017)
