During the reporting period, 2,749 households in North and south Darfur were provided with ES/ NFI items from the NFI Common Pipeline through implementing partners. A breakdown of distributions can be seen in the table below.

Renewal Distributions

► Background

An interagency vulnerability assessment carried out August 2016 to assess the needs of the protracted IDPs in Kebkabiya Locality. UNHCR/ESNFI team, with HAC and KSCS verified 509 extremely vulnerable IDP Households, NFIs from the Common pipeline were not provided at the time due to limited stocks as a result of items being held up by customs in the Port. Following the release of stock, distribution took place in December. by KSCS.

Displacement due to Disaster: Fire

► Background

Some 28 households in Abuhemira, Sortony and Zamzam IDP camps in El Fashir and Kebkabiya localities were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by fire. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 14 households following verification by partners Plan, SAG and KSCS.

Renewal Distributions

► Background

ES/NFI sector partners WVI and African Charitable Society for Mother and Child Care (ACSMCC) conducted a vulnerability assessment in Bulbul Timbisco, Alsalam IDPs camp, Mershing and Manawashi localities to identify protracted EVI and PSN households that needed ES/NFI assistance. Of the 2265 households on the list provided by community leaders, 2,134 were identified as extremely vulnerable households and were provided with ES/NFIs from the NFI CP by partner WVI.

Another vulnerability assessment was carried out in late November by UNAMID-ODO in Tulus locality among protracted IDPs in Tulus. UNHCR/ESNFI team participated in the verification exercise, and 50 extremely vulnerable households were assisted with ES/NFIs from the NFI CP

Refugees

► Background

UNHCR/ESNFI Project and COR-South Darfur conducted an assessment and registration of South Sudanese new arrivals in Buram locality in November. The mission identified 56 families that had arrived in July/August who were found to be in dire need of ES/NFIs. The families were assisted with ES/NFIs from the NFI CP to prevent further delay in response. The items will be replaced from the South Sudanese stock.
