# of families/households that have received at least 1 LLINS.



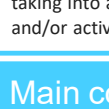
**15,366** (49 % of target)

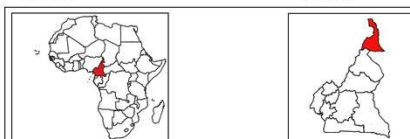
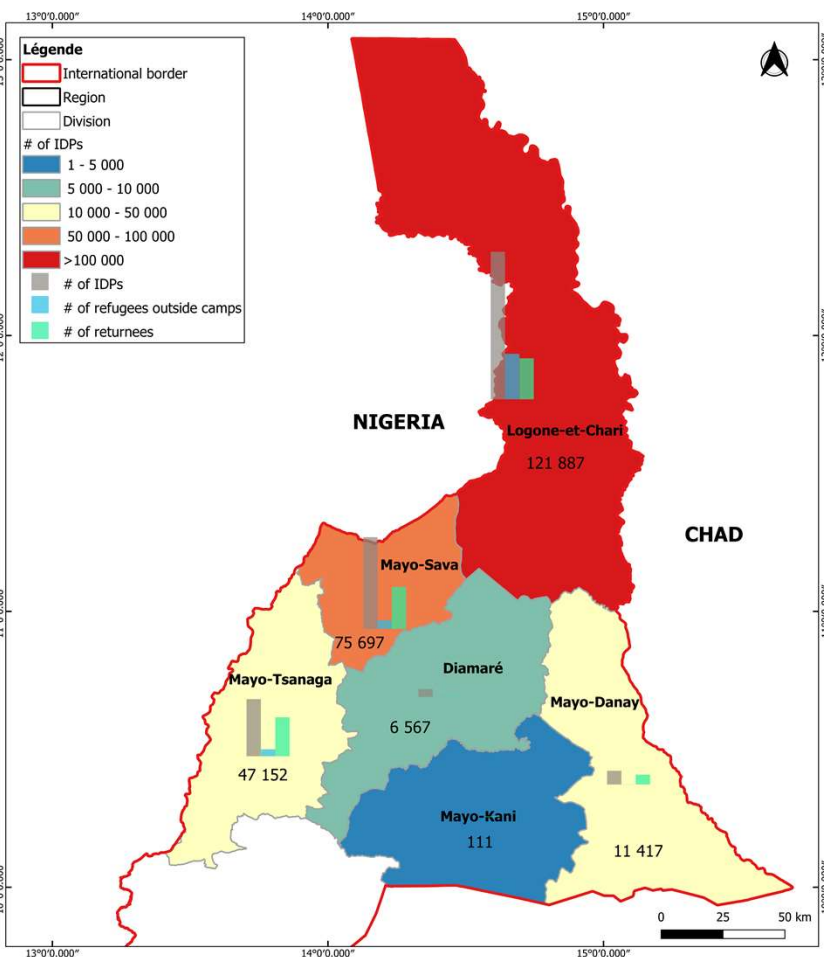
