

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on Typhoon “URSULA”

14 December 2020, 6PM

Situation Overview

This is the final report on the Typhoon “Ursula” that occurred on 23 December 2019. “Ursula” intensified into a typhoon on 24 December 2019, as it moved toward Eastern Visayas; hence, also affecting Northeastern Mindanao, Bicol Region, Central Visayas, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA and Western Visayas. On 28 December 2019, “Ursula” weakened into a Tropical Storm (TS) and exited PAR.
